That you can ask deeper questions you like this Shall we open it Um She left at the studio So thank you Danielle We're really excited Look how beautiful this is It's all about the presentation It's not all about the presentation but the presentation helps Let me look at this question Everything OK I'm gonna ask you a deep question Oh wait no this is I think this is the instructions It looks like I never read the instructions question everything When have you felt the closest to magic in your life You don't have to say right now I know right off the top of my head I know OK I was in South Beach Uh Spring break I no actually I sold my electric guitar in college to get down to South Beach and I was in the water floating and South Beach like ocean star I looked up at the sky and just had like this like very a massive immense sense of peace and I've yet to have it again And that was back in 20 felt close to magic Since that since that that that that like I feel so sad Why Because my closest thing to magic is this set and having this talk show No that's not what I'm supposed to say That's I co create this with Andy Of course this is the closest thing This is not this is not your magic This is what you're saying You're basking in the South Beach waters you know in the middle of spring break Oh I'm sorry you're just basking on your own talk show But that's OK We don't have to go there We don't have to go there Ask one more question and we'll get into what what's the closest besides this show Honestly I was born to tell stories I tell a story So tell us a story When I was seven years old I asked my dad to borrow his camcorder I then set it up in my basement and I started talking to the camera and said welcome to the Michelle Show And I would do that every single day in my basement And I do believe I was training my brain and my body for one day to uh coincide with L A and what's happening today OK You know you you don't have to be like full of uh and that is a real answer OK What I get real That is real I want to get real What else do you want me to say This is besides the magic you know that picture you know the picture of tell tell us a story besides the show What's the closest you ever felt to magic Yeah I think just like having this incredible opportunity to see the way life is with with uh pink glasses Yeah I believe that that's true of her when she was on prices No don't get me No no no no no no no Yes I do I think I have been given the opportunity to see the world with uh with the lenses of a child and I am grateful for that but I mean I have maturity It's just that like I can see things in a way that yeah I can just see things like with a brighter sense of like

wonder which we lose which you lose After a certain time the show would be depressive It wasn't it was just your side It would just be depressing We do have an amazing guest today Mr William D Johnson Oh can we get some talking about stem cells and how um and and and what they're doing um over at uh if I'm saying it right I'm saying it right Yes Um uh We're really excited to learn more about like what is going on over there Um I've heard about stories about people being able to walk again Um just getting like all like healthy and and wellness and and and stem cells and and they don't just do stem cells They saw they also do treatments for looking better So it's not just feeling better You also look better So I'm excited to to know more about that Um And I had the opportunity of running into the I was literally sitting in my car and I saw them walking across with our lovely friend Cary Ann And I was like they look amazing I was like who are they And I was like oh it's an and our guest and I got so excited and we all walked into creation together and you look you looked like a fashion like it looked like a fashion maga It looked like a magazine when we were walking in Yeah Yeah Yeah Like all these all these firemen were like I like the outfits What they said it's true They're like like the outfits even though they were like sitting next to me it was kind of awkward for them to say like the outfits Uh speaking of like the outfit M AM studios Yeah M AM studios is in full effect It started uh not even um a full week ago Uh It literally yeah No Wednesday Well the thought has been in the thought has been in the wheels since 19 No I'm just kidding I've been hearing about it since about October I say yeah I mean I actually brought it up to and we're standing outside of studio place and I said I've always wanted to have my own studios when I look at someone and when I talk to someone I am inspired to have a show and it happens every day all the time and it happens from a like a conversation and then all of a sudden my wheel start turning and then I'm like oh this would be a great scripted show This would be a great commercial This would be a great movie and it doesn't stop Right Um actually I I thought this was really sweet as you can as you can see Um I thought this is really cool Uh I got an email this morning saying we should submit for the Emmys I did hear that is awesome I thought that was so cool Um It was one of the best day time talk shows and um I sent it over to Andy and Andy was like I don't I think it's the deadline has already passed but it has not passed and we're really excited because uh this would be great We'll see Yeah we'll see fingers crossed fingers crossed we'll see Um um But if you want to connect with us you got to follow us at Good underscore Day live on Instagram Good underscore Day live on tiktok We're

and Charlotte It was uh at the grove It was really fun Um Well let's get into what you brought uh Kyle's corner What's going on Kyle I want to know what we saw on this Everyone in the studio What do we sign on this You guys at home What what is this man in Australia with you That's the these people are doing so much down there This man took a platypus out of the wild and took it on a shopping spree OK Wait what He just took he found a platypus in the wild picked it up and then took it with him for the deck and then brought it back to his natural habitat afterwards And the town is gonna sue him like \$200,000 for doing So I want to know where everyone where everyone sides on this personally This man is a saint He picked an animal up gave it a wonderful day and put it back home like he's better than Uber and we're gonna find him He didn't do anything to the animal The animal they have him on tape He brought it to the mall brought it around the food court brought it back home That's in the place My point is my point is the endangered species So I follow a page specifically You don't follow anything that's going on in real time You just follow a page of random stuff I don't think that's correct my friend but I just want to know like would you do you think it's absurd to do what he did Yeah It was a it was a bun That's weird I'm gonna pick up a random bunny on the side Let's let's go shopping to it Like what No you would be Charlotte My dog short a like who I had known and had for the past two years It's a random animal walking on the side of the street I would pick up a first of all I think they're endangered end I don't think they I don't think it's like a thing I don't think they're endangered You really don't think they're endangered No I mean I don't know if they're endangered But listen I think it's a well you don't know platypus maybe they get aggressive It has it doesn't even have teeth doesn't have teeth It has a beak that's the most threatening animal in the world with a long time You know That's so creepy dude I love this guy I don't know I'm not behind it I get into my and my animal activists so they have found a way to make leather out of mangoes out Yeah The Netherlands started at first Oh no Wait maybe it's Finland One of those Nordic countries How are you able to make leather out of the process right here So they they take they they're taking mangoes they take the the the pit out and then they put like an oil in it and it makes it real tough Then they just scoop it out just like this send it over or sorry then cook it right into like a flat sheet It makes you want to eat it Right It looks good Still can you eat it Right Ok But that's that's the right And now they're gonna send it to this guy He puts he puts like a finishing touch on it and then he gets just get sent to the designer right after that So that's that's

going to save animals a lot of lives We're all just going to be eating our
purses I mean I will don't bring mango leather around me I'll really have
mango over here I have mango So here's the comparison Did you see the two
shoes next to each other Oh my gosh That is cool It's really cool I have a lot
of questions They make What Oh that's cool See I don't know I wanna know
like I wanna know what love is I I just wonder like you have this fruit what is
about the oil that's going on top of it That's going to keep it from you know
disintegrating because fruit does not stay on shelves for a really good
question Good question But just like when we say like dried mangoes how
long do they last I don't think very long That's true Why doesn't it rot Like
why doesn't it rot It does rot after time I don't know I'm gonna have to ask
your shoes Start molding Can you Oh my God Can you imagine Look here's
here's the comparison again I love my shoes Can tell the difference I love
shoes Isn't that cool It's cool Thank you for bringing that up on Kyle's corner
I I appreciate you Kyle's corner I think you have something else before we
get to our special guest 00 I sent this to you Kyle Look how cute this is um
Children are so pure This is a little girl um giving water to a man on the
street who needed it Look how sweet Look how sweet she is We're all about
uh good news here Um and it just you know it just warms our heart Look
how sweet Look how sweet look Look look oh my heart my heart is like I
wanna be a daddy so badly slow your roll My friends who is this and then
we'll get to our guest Who is this Dion Sanders She is one of the best
football players of all time We each have a rock that we live under Mine is
the football rock I live under a football rock and know nothing about football
She lives under everything else She's very correct on that So this is just Dion
Sanders talking about how no one ever came to his high school games His
parents never rooted for him No one ever rooted for him He had to root for
himself I love that And that's really where he got his attitude from of for
playing that And he said that's the difference between me and a lot of people
I had to I had to see for myself I had to see my goals for myself by myself
and then reach them by myself And I think that's why I'm so powerful to
continue to be successful is because I really don't depend on anyone else I
really don't expect anyone to tell me yes or no I see something I want it I get
it That's it You're Ariana Grande I see it I like it I want it I got it and that's
not how it goes like that We'll be right back William D Johnson Don't go
anywhere We'll be right back after this I save the world save the hot here I
mean it feels good I like it hot I like it I like it warm I'm not wearing a whole
lot That's true I have like seven more layers You don't have to wear layers

You can wear what you wore in your audition to hilarious You not gonna wear that shirt You know they requested a shirtless I know I saw that and so here is our Jackie Unbox It you wanna get it charged up You use this fantastic charger over here This is the output over there and it has an extra cable like this with the ability to charge it in your car So that is really cool So we have it all charged up It has here you can press on the display You can see now that it is not drawing any power it is not bringing in any power and it is 99% charged which is cool So as you want to use all your separate things you can turn on the little lights and it will show you as you can see there that now you can draw power out of them or you can turn them off just like you would at home If you do if you wanna leave something plugged in but not having a draw power there you can turn it off So let's have some fun and see what our Jay can fire up So in the past we have used the Jari to light up our lives with go We have charged our cell phones and we have done a few other things But oh we've even lit up the Arrow Garden How amazing is that that we were able to light up the Arrow Garden But today we're gonna push the query to the limit And uh we are gonna take a look at the this works What's this This works That car vacuum Awesome Very cool And we could even take a look at Tabi used it And uh how amazing is this Oh my goodness You can just keep on going and going and going You can get into every little look and cranny in your car with all of this How awesome So this is what we're gonna do We're gonna stick it into our Jari Let's do it this way So you guys can see what I'm doing Turn it on There's a little light and the display have gone on because we are about to fire this up Thank you Mr Jackie There we go That is cool So let's see what else we can fire up today I mean that you can I mean that is just so cool You see powerful vacuum Jay fired it up Let's have a look at some of the other things that we can um fire up today Let's see Yeah we got it So let's try the LaVoy Air purifier I mean this is a high power drawing eye item I think I would imagine So it's not something that you would generally plug into this little power port here Amazing if this works you know how incredible this must be So not only is the Jari used when you are camping or exploring the world in your RV or your car The Jakey can also be your backup power source for a disaster Um You know disaster preparedness The Jay is definitely something that you'd want to have in your home and like God forbid there is something and the air is not pure and now you're stuck in your home You've got no power You can't put your air purifiers on If there's a huge amount of dust in the air or if there's a big um you know like we are in California there could be a huge earthquake will

bring up a lot of dust but you obviously want to still keep your lungs protected Let's see if the Jari not only will give us power but will also save lives So plug it in over here we'll turn it on That's a good thing April 7th 2023 We're so happy You're in the studio with me Yeah T and the lovely William D Johnson No thank you for inviting me Thanks for being here I was saying I ran into you and the lovely crew that came with you um outside of the building to creation Um We got a chance to talk for two seconds I said I don't want to ruin anything I want to wait till we sit down How are you I'm doing really well Glad to be here Glad to have you Thanks for coming man Uh So if I understand correctly you're at the forefront of science with stem cell research We like to think we're pioneers in regenerative medicine Yeah Yeah That's amazing What what got you into that It's really it's actually very personal I was diagnosed about 13 years ago I was diagnosed with late stage heart failure and I was given about a year and a half to live and I have two daughters and that was totally unacceptable prognosis to me So I went and did something that was very experimental at the time and I had to go to the Bahamas to do it because it's not legal in the US And um we used stem cells taken from my own fat and then went up through my femoral artery and injected my heart and I got a little better I got better I wasn't dying anytime soon So then progressed 10 years And I go to Thailand and I heard they were doing I got in an accident It's kind of a long story But I ended up realizing medical system There is amazing It's the number one medical tourism destination in the far east Their hospital system is amazing And um so I got yeah I was thinking oh I'm gonna do medical tourism and I just happened to find out that they were doing stem cells there too So I tried a treatment because it's a totally different type of cell They're using these perinatal tissue which is birth tissue not from an embryo No there's no there's no uh ethical concern here But these cells are far more powerful We just gave me an IV and within a month or two all of a sudden I realized not only was my heart function much better but my memory got better My cognitive function got better and I just felt amazing So that began I gotta do this for a living I gotta get into this and I became obsessed and started started researching all this stuff's online By the way you can you can find all these clinical trials online that show how amazing these cells work And I'm not gonna go into why you don't hear about it in this country and why the FDA just came out and said you cannot use stem cells for anything that's not clinic you know FDA approved for can't do them off label Pretty much everything we do is off label because there's anyway in Thailand if it's safe they let you do it

clinically but in the US they have to prove it's safe Then it takes maybe another 10 years before you do it clinically So Thailand Thailand was the place that's and and tell us so you it's to me it's so fascinating when we have these moments in our lives that are terrifying and almost like close to destruction I believe it creates room for real growth and purpose And it sounds like you had this moment of almost dying and and realizing this is my purpose and this is what I want to do And I think that's so beautiful and terrifying at the same time obviously nobody should have to go through that But so tell me and this is how Den started Um And uh and the name is personal to you Yes My middle name it goes back 16 generations of my family So I'm very proud to put the family name on the clinic because we do really good work And I also interesting enough was Demorest films before I made a lot of oh well maybe you want to team up with M AM studios that kind of movie you like to make I made to produce Hacksaw Ridge which Academy Award I love Andrew Garfield Such a sweetheart Oh my gosh But Mel is one and I got to see this story because Mel Gibson is one of the reasons I got into Sim Sos too He treated his father who was in a wheelchair at 90 his father lived to be 100 and four walking I just treated this last week My father who's 90 we're still waiting for you know it takes a couple of months for the cells to really do their work and what a gift to give him back something Do you feel like you're just like saving lives and extending lives Like I you know I I don't wanna sound full of myself but we're witnessing miracles every day That's incredible That's amazing That's really deep work and probably the most important on the planet at the moment That's in I mean when people find out and the information is all there right When people really realize how powerful this medicine you can biologically reduce your age about that about biological versus chronological And how are you able to test some of these biological age Well one of the best ways now is it called the cell methylation test And I don't want to get too into the science but it's very accurate I can tell you within a year how old you are If you've never done any work I can tell you within a year how old you are based on the cell methylation That's really cool That's really cool Thing is after we treat you with stem cells generally you're about five years biologically young Wow Can I get rid Grace They asked me to audition today for like a 28 year old I was like are you sure But that's can you get rid of gray Yes Yes You know I wear a T shirt around you know free advertising for you That's one of the things that does best grow hair Oh yeah Oh yeah Oh yeah No no no I think calling him every day I'm like did you did you did you get the thing for

the hair yet again Like I got his number Don't worry you're not getting it That's great That's fantastic I mean pretty much any any tissue you can um any any chronic illness that's related to age is treatable with stem cells I had type two diabetes pretty bad I had peripheral um not neuropathy neuropathy I'm a little I got a little confused Yeah I was getting numbness like in my feet and stuff and um and it's gone nerves came back My I no longer am a type two diabetic and it's um is it having uh fights and battles against this national structure No because we can't operate here You don't even operate Yeah But I just I want people to know that this is available I mean my friend just came from L A He was in a wheelchair for a year and he had really bad type type two diabetes to the point where you know he has insulin and stuff and um in the first week after doing stem cells he was walking we do a on this Yeah No we're gonna he's he that's one of the one of the most magical things I've ever seen because I even my own doctor told him I don't think we're gonna be I don't think it's gonna it's gonna be of much help because it's pretty you're pretty advanced But his mind the mind is so powerful it all starts in the mind doesn't realize how powerful the mind is and to see it work in reality to physical itself that the human body Yeah I mean what all cellular medicine is is helping the human body doing what it already does It just kind of forgets as we age Yeah Right It seems to keep up the good work really well Like we have stem cells in all of our tissues and as you age especially if you're over 50 they get tired So they don't pick up the signals when the body says produce you know we need more tissue here We need to fix this They're they're napping So what the cells do that we put in these perinatal cells there It's like a foreman with a bullhorn going up Wake up That's so interesting So I'm like can you imagine waking up with that in your ear So but my uh I'm a little verse on cellular regeneration like the telomeres for instance Well they're more of like it's like a it's like grow fuel So like once the telomere runs out the cell can no longer uh double essentially Uh And what is it like 50 times it's supposed to double some I think it's it depends on the cell type but I think it's 30 to 50 to 50 And and I I assume stem cell research helps the telomere the cell it lengthens the telomeres As a matter of fact a lot of the different treatments from N AD which is a great treatment nicotin dinucleotide it's in all your cells But as you age that decreases So we just raise that level that helps the telomere There's a lot of treatments that extend telomere length which it's gonna extend your life You said that by the way earlier you said something about aging to 100 Yes we are so far beyond that now really literally I believe there's a chance that I won't die It's it's

Uh And it was all natural is what he said Hilarious I do hear though that one of the keys to Long Life is going to bed at the same time every night I try to do that I can't do it I try to go to bed every night at 10 But uh the last couple weeks I have had to extend that to about 12 or one I think once I hit like 50 maybe 55 I'll start like 10 o'clock That's it don't And I'm um let's let's let's uh give Danielle a special shout out for leaving these cards at the studio Thank you Danielle They're beautiful We're gonna play a game with them Can I can Yeah Yeah Yeah You wanna play um you this is all about um questioning everything and this is all for deeper questions Danielle Did Great great box great card box Question everything All right here we go What compliment do you hear the most to me You have great energy I think that's my smile I think Yeah Ok Which means the most to you Which what which means the most to you Which one makes you the most uncomfortable Oh ok Which compliment means the most to you Out of all the compliments you Oh that you just have this deposit disposition deposition My dad's an attorney So I heard that this morning the truth Ok No I I think the greatest compliment to me is the uh disposition that I have It's that I have a very um opening welcoming disposition and a very um especially when I'm around other people I'm very sunny and bright Um and I will never ever ever make anyone feel not um not like being shined upon that they have the opportunity to feel authentically them and in a safe space So that that to me is that to me is very important that helps me because my my thing is being funny and you help me be comfortable so I can be funny Well I love helping other people feel comfortable Here's a question which compliment makes you the most uncomfortable for me A compliment that makes me feel the most uncomfortable Uh you got great legs but I wear a lot of shorts and like a lot of skirts that I don't think that's asking for Kanye complains about the paparazzi This is the question is what's the one that makes the most most uncomfortable You got great legs I mean it's like thanks Like I know I don't know Like how do you how do you respond to that They are out every day They'll be out as long as they possibly can until I'm 100 and five with that It might be uh for 100 and 35 which makes me the most uncomfortable I don't know I don't really know What compliment do you get that makes you uncomfortable You're hot Not really like Idris Elba don't get comfortable about that either I think you would where people are like compliments don't make me uncomfortable Really What makes you uncomfortable Uh someone what makes me uncomfortable you know what I get embarrassed for people I it's hard for me to get embarrassed myself Like if something if I slip fall and

everyone laughs I'm like oh that just happened But if someone else slips and falls I'm like cringing like it Like oh my God I can't imagine how embarrassed they are You're such a sweet dude Uh ok You'd never know it You would never know it Never unless you get to know Kyle Yeah What is the most challenging part of what you do for a living Yeah You want the honest truth Um I move really fast So like when it comes to like this show or it comes to like working on scripted shows Like I move very very fast and like I want my other teammates to move just as fast And when they don't get from you talking about me I don't know who I'm talking about I'm just talking about people in general What do you mean You don't know who you're talking about I didn't I didn't say it was you I was just I'll give you an example Uh Charlotte Chronicles Uh I had the idea the idea was stimulated I started writing I had a writing partner at the time She was like let's start next week I said no this isn't gonna work It's not gonna work I was moving fast and what ended up working out for me is it's happening in here I don't know fast and like other people are moving slow They didn't say you were moving slow I don't feel like I'm moving slow I didn't say you were moving slow I just no no I'm not saying that here I just say sometimes I want my team to do everything I'm doing and that's frustrating because I'm a type a person and I want to do You want everyone to do what you're doing Yeah Like I want I want like multiply myself OK Yeah that's the thing I think that also pertains to this for me Just teammates Um You know in general but I'm not a good teammate You are You're a very good team 000000 yeah But I mean like if anything challenging is going to come it's going to come from your teammates Yeah Yeah for sure Yeah just in general and I've had teammates all over the board football teammates talk show teammates acting teammates directors directors are probably the biggest challenge because if you don't have a good director it makes the job so much harder It must be hard as an actor because I too am an actor But II I can't totally uh claim that I am an actor Uh just because I don't really like people telling me what to do but I am a good actor Um I just more I like I'm more in the Reese Witherspoon Arena Directors are kind of tough if you don't have a good one Uh And I don't think directors really tell you what to do They kind of enlighten you or try to help you understand ask really good questions to help you kind of open up your brain to a different perspective Good directors are good at that Some directors that are just like no yes no and yes directors those are tough to work with you know who's a really good director to work with our buddy Dan Shep who is here what Wednesday I can't believe that was already

Wednesday So so so talented um and Emmy Award winning uh as well Uh
What would you what would younger you not believe about your life today
Oh What would younger me not believe about my life today I don't think
younger me as much as she practice writing and and filming her Barbies
together and like like in like a movie formats and like talk shows space Like
uh if she knew I even though I used to practice believe it or not in my mom's
bathroom I practice with my shoulder like my head over my shoulder And I
would hear over here over here and I was like on the red carpet And um if
you told me the best thing I've ever heard you do you never practice winning
an award with a shampoo bottle You might want to start practicing I just
never really needed the practice I feel like I got it I got it You know what I do
I do envision like what I would say a lot in my head I just never like grabbed
the bottle and like sat there and be like oh thanks so much Well it's cool to
like practice it because when you practice it you feel it and you feel like what
it's like to have those moments You know a lot of people like that would train
for the Olympics they would practice what it's like to win the award Like it's
it's like getting it into your body into your mind into the whole belief because
like your body doesn't know the difference between um pretend and real So
