good You don't look good Are you gonna Yeah you are all right I'll move and as soon as I move it comes my way and I'm like see this is what I'm talking about This is what I'm talking about Why I don't do public transportation That's why I don't do anything People invite me to parties I say I'll I'll zoom you Not True You are the party What do you mean you zoom We have some more today Oh my gosh We are continuing to binge the bay today Um today is the big release of um yeah big big day binge in the bay Um you can stream all of it Um it's on Vog today Um they have a can I say they have a party today because they wear it in moving on moving on We have some incredible people We have Jaclyn Emmy Award of Emmy along with Mike Manning awarding actor Um They're big on the bay They've been part of the bay and we're so excited to binge the bay with them Don't go anywhere We'll be right back after this that rain Thanks for saying anywhere not nowhere anywhere anywhere much more comfortable now No no no hurts hurts to hear So here is our Jari Unbox It you wanna get it charged up You use this

fantastic charger over here This is the output over there and it has an extra cable like this with the ability to charge it in your car So that is really cool So we have it all charged up It has here you can press on the display you can see now that it is not drawing any power it is not bringing in any power and it is 99% charged which is cool So as you want to use all your separate things you can turn on the little lights and it will show you as you can see there that now you can draw power out of them or you can turn them off just like you would at home If you do if you wanna leave something plugged in but not having a draw power there you can turn it off So let's have some fun and see what our Jay can fire up So in the past we have used the Jay to light up our lives with go We have charged our cell phones and we have done a few other things but oh we've even lit up the Arrow Garden How amazing is that that we were able to light up the Arrow Garden But today we're gonna push the Jari to the limit and uh we are gonna take a look at the this works What's this This works Vaca vacuum Awesome Very cool And we could even take a look at it Tabi used it And uh how amazing is this Oh my goodness You can just keep on going and going You can get into every little look and cranny in your car with all of this How awesome So this is what we're gonna do We're gonna stick it into our query Let's do it this way So you guys can see what I'm doing Turn it on It's a little light and the display have gone on because we are about to fire this up Thank you Mr Jay There we go That is cool So let's see what else I'm sorry This is like the the music is just so it's so good We had to dance a little bit Yes Like this is my contract I understand it's fine Get some music Do you hear it on the show When you when you're filming We should do we should get you in the mood a little bit You know what I mean Like that He'll be like what are you doing for my actors Welcome to the show We got Emmy Award winning Mr Mike Manning Welcome I'm doing well How are you We're great Every day is great here on uh on on this show and especially while we're binging the Bay which is available now on to b um and many streaming um platforms Um I believe so you joined the Bay recently right Season five season five so not too long ago Um And your character Caleb Um Can you tell us a little bit about Caleb and and how you um well first how did you know what I'm gonna go back How did you meet how did you meet everyone So I met Gregory and Christos uh and some of the cast at a Laney their entertainment company was a lay mixer Um And I had met Gregory and he kind of like halfway through the conversation he kind of looks at me and I'm like what's what's going on I'm going on my face and he goes I've been thinking of a

love interest for one of my series regulars and I think he would be good for it Do you wanna let's have a conversation about it I said ok great Thank you So he brought me on as K club in season five as a love interest for Daniel Garrett So in the Bay the Garretts are like the family uh the powerful family And so he brings me in as a love interest to Daniel played by Eric Nelson And uh and in season five their their best uh that are United And then in season six we see their relationship uh sort of get more serious more serious They they realize that there's sort of love there Absolutely not just friendship And then um and then there's season seven where everything uh blows up That is I I think that's incredible how um we we've learned that Gregory J Martin is such a visionary and um your story is no different than a lot of the other cast members who are like he'll just look at them and then be like I have an idea Yeah Right You're absolutely right And that's it's nice too when that is the case because when you feel like you're sort of picked um so much of an entertainment in Los Angeles You know this it's like waiting by the phone for permission to be good enough to play in somebody else's sandbox And what Gregory has been able to do is he's created the sandbox that makes everybody feel like family It's almost like when it's a big Thanksgiving dinner and everybody pulls up a chair and um and with most new shows you feel like the new kid in school and I never felt like that on the bay immediately They just sort of welcome me with open arms He listens to what I have to say about the character and um takes my uh you know opinion seriously which a lot of shows don't do with actors So it's been a really positive experience So he takes your opinions You have like uh certain ideas and you can voice them and he implements them Yeah he does or he has a reason not to but at least you feel like you you're heard That's great How does your character inspire you the actor So Caleb uh my character is very sweet He's very honest He's very loyal He's very uh what you see is what you get which uh which is nice I don't know why but I I tend to play a lot of bad guys I don't know so so much so that I I I've been in L A for 11 years now About six years in my mom calls me one day and she goes and I had done you know on her like major crimes Why 50 cloud nine Disney I was a Disney bad guy and uh she calls him one day She goes Mike Is there something that you you wanna share Are you are you like a mean person And I was like mom No he's acting and so with Caleb it's nice because he's he wears his heart on his sleeve It's what you see is what you get And so it's it's it's a really it's he's been a really fun character to play And in season seven uh so in season six you sort of you learn that about him you learn that

he is honest and loyal and sweet You sort of fall in love with the relationship that he has with Daniel And then in season seven he's taken to the jungles of Puerto Rico where none of those qualities are helpful Uh So he's he's going up against all these bad guys And and so you're seeing a sort of fish out of water story where his kindness and his loyalty and his inability to hide anything he's feeling uh don't do him any good So it's sort of a different it's a it was a different um way to play that character and and sort of discover different aspects of that character And uh and it was a lot of fun I had never been to Puerto Rico before Yeah that that's really interesting It seems like uh like a fish out of water kind of a circumstance Gregory's uh writing kind of keeps you on your toes as an actor Um so are you learning as you go or are are you able I saw this coming Ok This is cool Or this is you know how well it's always exciting when you get a new script because you're almost like oh what's the road map Like where am I driving today kind of thing Yeah Right And and especially with a character uh that you're able to play season after season know the character you know um how you're like them how you're not like them what you enjoy playing everything else but you still don't know where the car is gonna drive Right So uh so with season seven it was really exciting because audiences with all the cast not just Kayla but with all the cast members they've fallen in love and they've seen these characters in seasons one through six And then in season seven you take all of those characters and you sort of throw them in an environment where they've never been And I think that audiences will see a lot of characters uh in that fish out of water kind of space Oh I love that You're plugging it so well you can see it on our screen right here to be to be you can binge the bay with us as we've been doing for the past week which has been super fun Yeah and getting to meet you know some of your castmates and and um obviously Gregory J Martin and Wendy Rich and Christos It's just like so fun to like see all the the family behind the family family behind the family Um We have a clip of you can we play the clip Here we go Daniel today is uh the best day of my life I'm so lucky that I get to spend the rest of my life with you Pete Hey what's up Nothing yet No no stop Sorry I just I I just I know you're used to doing this whole lone wolf thing but that is not gonna work with me the way that Vivian is your life Daniel is mine So whatever journey this thing takes you on I'm gonna be right there with you You got that But I promise to always be your safety net to always give you a soft place to live I promise to to share in your joy and and be there for you in in your time of sorrow I uh it's fine I about to love you through the good times in the band

Oh so good Um And that was the first same sex wedding scene uh for the show Um And then you won an Emmy last year for your role as Caleb uh best supporting actor What what does all that feel like for you Well I mean winning an Emmy feels amazing uh because it's now in other jobs it's like oh you did a good job you get a promotion you did you you did this report and now you have you know you have this on your resume with entertainment It's almost like as actors we're going around peddling our wars hoping that somebody likes what we're doing and it's so vulnerable and so much of it is full of rejection that when you get something like a golden statue that just is the industry's way of saying you're doing a good job keep it going Um It's it's really nice and it's really it's you know you have a sense of achievement and then above that just to have that be one for something like a same sex wedding storyline Um And I said this when I accepted the speech I said well first of all I thanked my parents I thanked my grand grandparents because they always encouraged me um to follow my dreams and and uh but then I went on there and I said you know if there's one young person watching this storyline and this storyline helps them feel like they are worthy of that love and that acceptance and that same type of fairy tale that everybody else feels like they're worthy of Uh then this entire season was worth it And and and that's how I feel I I feel like it's it's amazing to create art that you enjoy It's also amazing to create art that you're proud of And that storyline is one that I'm really proud of it Like you're really proud of like your your artwork actually connecting with the audience as well as as the with the cultures as well Um Was that in in you did you have that is that what made you want to become an actor Like let's back all the way up to what got you We've been working together for a very long time Yeah Yeah Yeah Um Yeah I just I uh I think the nice thing about art is that you're you're able to reflect certain things back onto yourself and on to society and that's why we go to the movies That's why we turn on our television is because we wanna see ourselves in these characters and we want to know that we're not the only ones with that struggle or we're not the only ones with that you know something amazing and that we we we do that because we we want content to mirror itself back on us and and see ourselves in in those lives And so um yeah I think when I when I can do that fun fact the suit that I wore during that wedding scene that you just saw was my actual suit that I wore during my wedding So so that was kind of a cool yeah it was kind of a cool thing when when art can imitate life like that it's really special When was it When did you get married Oh God I have to get this right Or else we'll be right

back 5.5 years ago Is that I know That's awesome I'm all for it and he looks at us like you know I'll give you a divorce lawyer's number or you want to get married Um because I always talk about like I think it's a beautiful thing to do I haven't done it yet But um yeah I think you know what I love what you said about um winning the Emmy It was like good job Keep going because I think a lot of people and we've had this conversation about the Oscars It's like I wanna but like it's not that you want it's you don't stop like you don't want to stop doing it I mean maybe for some people Yeah Sure But I think that's the question Like how do you not let it get to your head Right Because that's a very big that's a huge award There's really nothing above an Emmy time television goes Yeah Yeah exactly Like I yeah I would I would love an Oscar someday and by the way you walk out the door throw an o no but I mean Jamie Lee Curtis with her for such a long career Um and then winning an Oscar for everything everywhere all at once this past week Uh she's not gonna stop acting if anything it's going to embolden her uh and Michelle yo like it's going to embolden them and everything everywhere all at once in general it's going to embolden the industry to to take risks and to keep telling these stories and the fact that that one just sends the message I think to Hollywood that uh there are so many more stories to tell and that we don't need to make fast And The Furious is 17 Um Again if they want to cast me in fast 17 that's fine Not counting that out Uh I wouldn't do that but Right Yeah But but I I think uh I think Sequels and Blockbusters and Marvel movies are great and they have a space in that escapism and that fun But I also think that there are so many other stories that need to be told and when you win something like an Emmy or an Oscar or a Grammy or uh you know uh uh Critics Choice Award or Golden Globe or you know it's just it's just I think the industry's way of saying keep telling those stories and and and feel comfortable in the story that you want to tell Everybody has their own journey everybody has their own point of view and the song they're trying to sing And um and so you know it's little things like those little golden awards and that 75 seconds on stage or whatever it is Is it only 75 seconds I don't know I blacked out I blacked out every day on this show The opportunity comes to win an award I'm gonna be like well I'm just gonna keep talking like you can play the music I'm still gonna talk I'll still be here like I'm not you're gonna be like and then the music plays over and you just see your mouth moving I think yo did that was at the Golden Globes where they started playing the music and she's like I've waited my whole life for this I you come on stage beat you up I mean crouching Tiger Hidden Dragon like

100% like she would back up back up floats over So uh next question uh would be uh did you ever want the Emmy before You want it And did you ever expect it Did you not get it How do you work with that Let's like play the twilight zone It yourself Let's say you didn't win an Emmy Oh What's the what's the advice I get tough questions I'm sorry It is a tough question I mean of course there's if you think something's gonna happen and it doesn't happen Uh You're there's a little bit of heartbreak Um I feel like I've been in this industry long enough now where I'm I'm a tough show and I'm pretty good at um not letting myself crumble when I don't get that role or I don't you know get that thing I was shocked I did not think I was going to get it I was up against my senior partner Eric Nelson Um I was up against uh other two or two or three other actors that have a ton of credits and have been in this industry for decades And so I was like oh I'm just happy to be at this table Um I don't care what I eat kind of thing and I and I hen I won and I was shocked that attitude and I actually didn't even prepare a speech until I was in the Uber on the way to the show And I was like something in the back of my head told me I was like you know what I should just just my phone my notes app and I was like I'm just gonna type out a few talking points just in case Did you refer to them when you actually went up there Absolutely I blacked out But I I think I hit all my thank you the manager the Bay family and Gregory and everybody involved and Wendy for you know writing the story and um and then Eric for being my scene partner and the other nominees I think and my dogs and my I have two Pit bull Nice nice We get along in the world See I'm glad you said that because I used to live with a pit bull and the thing in the world they do I think it's just how you raise them No we won't get off topic Um but back back to one more for you Um you said your family is so supportive Were they like so like over the moon Oh they were over the moon They were yeah they told all their friends and all their it was it was great It was And and my grandmother unfortunately uh right before the Emmys she passed away And so you know it happens Um but she and I were very close and so II I sort of raised the golden statue and I was like this is for you Grammy and my mother especially saw that and she just called me and told me how sweet that was And um you know it's nice because I I believe she's she's looking down um proud of what I'm doing So it was nice to acknowledge her in that too I love that So my my question next for you is what can you say to uh those actors out there that are you know wanting to act like you or wanting to be on a show like you What can we say to them What what kind of that kind of advice can you share Yeah I mean if any

this How awesome So this is what we're gonna do We're gonna stick it into our query Let's do it this way So you guys can see what I'm doing Turn it on with a little light and the display have gone on because we are about to fire this up Thank you Mr Jackie There we go That is cool So let's see what else we can fire up today I mean that you can I mean that is just so cool You see powerful vacuum Jackie fired it up Let's have a look at some of the other things that we can um fire up today Let's see Yeah we got it So let's try the LaVoy Air purifier I mean this is a high power drawing eye item I think I would imagine So it's not something that you would generally plug into this little power port here Amazing if this works you know how incredible this must be So not only is the Jari used when you are camping or exploring the world in your RV or your car The Jakey can also be your backup power source for a disaster Um you know disaster preparedness The Jay is definitely something that you'd want to have in your home And like God forbid there is something and the air is not pure and now you're stuck in your home you've got no power You can't put your air purifiers on If there's a huge amount of dust in the air or if there's a big um you know like we are in California there could be a huge earthquake will bring up a lot of dust but you obviously want to still keep your lungs protected Let's see if the Jari not only will give us power but will also save lives So plug it in over here we'll turn it on and you can see let's actually put this up a little bit because you'll be able to see the lights So let's put that try and see if you can see that there this all in the name of ok there we go So the little light is on We have the did you see that Ok turn it on let's turn on the light so you guys can see There we go That is it So we have our it's just too good It's too good Jack You don't have to dance at all It's just you don't have to dance We like to dance in a little bit Oh yeah I'll dance any time anywhere I love it You yes I feel like we need like a drum set That's a good day If you're watching the show Welcome We have the lovely Jackie Zieman You are just like daytime royalty Tell me no it's the truth I speak the truth I I love the outfit I was a personal shopper No like this is the thing Well thank you I don't have a personal shopper This is just me But thank you You love your work and and I love that I'm getting to meet you Um You've been on General Hospital One Life to live Incredible We're celebrating 60th anniversary this week But 45 for me So wow You know I never thought I'd be old enough to say that you don't look so good You know you look fantastic You're fantastic And I think it's incredible that you're able to say that so many people will never be able to say that And and you are your your daytime royalty and and um General

Hospital we just had Mark Teschner on the show He's a love Yeah Interesting We love him and and love that everyone loves what they do and loves the shows that they work on Um not just General Hospital One Life to Live And then I mean so much more and then um the Bay You've been with the Bay since the baby beginning 99 seasons we only have on So I have to tell you because this is a fun story Tell me the story I like all fun So my daughter Lacy Rose I have two girls two daughters um Lacy Rose at the time was just going into college So that's how long ago she's 30 now But we're you know we're up in um uh San Diego and on the parents' day on set you know you when you go like uh on July to look at the rooms and the dorms So they put the parents on the side to go take them away and they put the kids in the group and my cell phone rings and it's Tristan Rogers So Tristan says oh hey hey mate Yeah how you doing I said well I'm actually on Lacy's you know college thing Rom for the day He said so my friend Gregory Martin is doing this show the Bay and I'm doing it you know and and we have some really really good people on you know Mary Beth and Michael Ashford He names like five people who are all like legends like people in daytime that really know what the hell they're doing He said and you know Gregory was wondering if you'd be interested in doing the show I said oh wow Well yeah he said ok I'll set up a phone call and then So you know so um Gregory called me the following you know a couple of days later and that was that and I was so excited to get on But it it's you know I've been lucky because I never had to audition I got on one life to live Age of night was actually my first baby role like one day talking with uh uh Dixie Carter I got to work with Dixie Car got to work with you She would be nothing in those days you know but I did have lines it was like an under five But that and then we went on to one life to live for 2.5 years which is great with a fabulous producer I can tell I can tell you Doris Quinlan's stories forever She yeah she was fab she was wonderful So she actually has a house or um well had a house up in Rhinebeck New York I'm from New Jersey I heard some more accents You said a couple of things you said door and floor and I was like this is OK in New Jersey Uh Well Bergen County Bergenfield right next door to you Jersey Jersey in the house Andy Waldman I want to come back uh not to get off the bay at all But I am interested when women inspire women And you were saying that Miss Quinlan inspired you the producer from One Life to Live I was just curious how she inspired That's a great question You know when I first you know went on I had very little experience and and until nobody in my family was ever in the television into movies or anything So I

didn't have anybody like ever taking me to a set or teaching me anything which was you know fine but very different from a lot of people that were really seasoned and knew what they were doing And I remember going on and all of a sudden my first week I had these in those days soaps were like 10 12 15 pages long one scene Wow So I'm on and I've got like four scenes five scenes you know six plus the t they call it the t the prologue in the beginning And I'm working with Jason Parker in a like a tube top to look like I have nothing on in bed Yeah My first scene with Jamison and then and then the director who is um David Pressman who is like a famous legend in the business Well then roll over do this do that and then roll over when you're done and he pulls the sheet down looks like you have no clothes on I'm like is he gonna show my crack I was like well ask him not to because we were like we're taping those days You might do like now you we're we're very like you say it goes on the air So we had to give our cameras to the news at six o'clock So we started taping at five The joke we were in our the joke was you had to change the topic at first because if you didn't have time to change the bottom they shoot you There was no do over or stop here Sometimes like the microphone is look like there's 30 of us but there's just four and I know you're amazing Thank you So thank you magic So here's the sign to speed up OK you're on a soap opera and you had to go This meant like and they give you starting a 12th countdown Do you know in 10 seconds you're not on TV So you have to finish your line and then this was stretched This was like OK we get that How do you think this was to you I don't know I was like II I had so many jobs like from when I came from Jersey I had so many jobs So when he was like this I was like is he making pizza That's such a dad joke Can you throw it up You growing up Like I was never a host She brought me on there was serendipity there and uh he was giving direction and so I was like he told me to steal third base I don't know what to say So but it's it was a testament to how you're going on live And did you ever have that where you were just like didn't change your bottoms You just had the top and they just shot you tight and just kept it rolling right But I was gonna try the sheet before I got out of the bed There you go There you go That's great That's great That's so amazing Oh sorry You know if you're if you're on a roll I want you to roll away because that's the um I wanted to come back to the bay Um what do you like What do you love so much about the bay that brought you in I mean is it the family we're hearing from everyone It's the family Yeah Well that's the thing with the bay You know first of all we don't have to rush like that I mean we do shoot because it has to happen you know um we

don't have any like set set so we're on location all the time but most locations are in the L A area You know sometimes depending on rush hour it could be a three hour drive from well I'm here living in Calabasas so not crazy But you know we we do shoot in a hospital and we have set sets there You yes we love her Yeah she she's great She's great So but a part of that it's a real hospital and I just have to say we get tested COVID every day whether it's the Bay Disney whatever every day So we're you know good clear but we would go into this hospital and it's a working hospital but there's a whole wing that they just use for shooting So it's great because probably the you all probably seen a million scenes that were shot in this actual hospital different ones you know over the years So it's kind of nice because the equipment's there the bed it's all real None of it's fake You help help your character Uh No no Uh I mean I will admit I do see like Sophia one thing we have in common to talk about in a minute I do see dead people I don't know I see I see I have since the time I was a little girl You know what I was Uh So this is an interesting story when I was so I'm very sensitive and very very uh open to things And when I was a little girl I used to tell my mom I see things mom I see things flying around in my room and she's like oh no Michelle you're fine I was like no I like see like like like like white white like yeah when I was super super little and my mom was like no no no you're fine You're fine You're fine And when um when my grandma passed I could not live I could not live I could not stay in her house because I I wasn't seeing it anymore I was see I was feeling I was feeling it and I was so so I don't know if you see and feel or like you just see I would see Well it started with me when I was young again The little white things some of them were not um good They were bad I feel them poking you sometimes Yeah it was weird My dog wouldn't come in my room We had a dog beagle and she would stay outside outside and she's a smart dog She actually got a medal once um a hero medal from saving all of us because our house got a fire Oh my God It was electrical in the walls and the roof blew off She got all of us out of the house I remember running down the hall having Gretel under one arm and stopping We had a you know hallway in the bathroom was a ranch house grabbing a towel and throwing it and throwing the towel over her So she wouldn't jump out of my arms and I ran past the fireplace in the kitchen and my mother had a picture wall you know of all the family and the kids and the weddings And I remember grabbing her wedding picture to my dad off the wall in one hand and having the dog on the other hand like well we got one picture left and we all got out to the curb and the roof blew off My dad

went back in my dad you know was a systems engineer you know brilliant with computers He worked for IBM and he had a prudential account It was his job to figure out a computer for potential which was the size of this room and you know couldn't do what our little cell phones can do But it was in those days you know a big deal So the roof and my dad went back in because he had a one of those fire boxes but it had like the house the birth certificates the all that stuff that you don't want to lose And he went back in again and I remember my mother going Richard don't don't don't And he did it and he and he made it out He was fine We all made and then the roof blew So I've had my experiences with fire over the years So you know when I have to watch something that's really dramatic on TV that has to do with fire or if I had to play something in fire that would seem really real to me because you know they said the subconscious doesn't differentiate between what you do as an actor and what you do as a person in real life It's all real You know it all goes in your psyche and it's all there which is why you get brilliant actress you know actors and actors you get you know Sandra Bullock and you get Meryl Streep and you get people who have done so many roles and they just layer layer and every role becomes bigger and better and more filled in because it has the capacity of everything that's been in the roles before That's fascinating to get to do like you like you and we're gonna look at a clip of you on the let's take a look right now at you and your and your awesome I have no clue what you're going to play you suppose Um Yes I described the person that shot Sarah that you could maybe sketch the perpetrator Yes I believe I could Yeah it's my beautiful baby boy Have you decided on a name I wanted to name him after Marley I wanted to honor her And then of course Matthew Vivian's cousin Ma and Matthew what a lovely name I'm sure they're both very proud Thank you He may not be able to keep all the promises he made to you Da I've seen the road ahead darling Jack and I up on it together your premonitions aren't always right Stop it Jack is going to be all right Riley I know it Oh there's a reason why you're Emmy nominated You're so good Um Sophia Madison Um I feel like did did Gregory know that you could see things I don't think so Maybe he saw things things are saw in me or maybe Wendy I don't know told him because Wendy and G we were working together and they do they do story together I think on the show So but yeah my my first with a real person was my like you grandma my grandmother and uh she came and her daughter my dad and aunt my aunt Millie were the two kids of my grandmother And I remember she came she appeared to me her life size person white I could see through

her younger than when she died You know angels They'd like to come back like when they're in their thirties or in their prime you know looking like with the hair done and the whole thing if it's women And uh I remember seeing her and I remember the next morning going we had the we had a party line on our phone in the kitchen and going to mommy mommy you know a Millie came last night She said yes Aunt Millie just called My grandma used to come to her and to me on the same night and she lived in Tennessee and in Tennessee her daughter So she come and said the same thing She'd always go at the end of the bed life size She'd sit on the stool at the end of the bed and I remember going to go daddy Do you want me to tell you next time she comes I'll I'll get you you can talk to your mom and she's like no no no Right Right Right Oh my God Things like that It can be very very uh disturbing Um but so it's it's really fun to see that you have this And so does your character has this too So it must be such so much fun to play because you can just tap into it to what's real Yeah Real And it was so good Mary Beth was great because it's really hard She had to do all these scenes where she's like in the bed She was like great because he's used to you know yak yak talk talk talk leading a story line So she had to do that and you know it was it was and then Tristan same thing when you saw that little scene he had a lot of you know he had a lot of words he came in and he's so funny Tristan no matter what his scene does I have to like always ask this especially for dramatic actors and actresses Um because I always lean towards the funny um do you ever like laugh between scenes with these guys Oh yeah it's like he's dying and it's like then you like crack a joke like just to ease a little bit of the tension just to But you know Gregory is great because he gives us time you know in this in the soap world on other shows I've worked boom the directors don't really direct acting They drop cameras you know there are five cameras Boom boo boo everything's iso now it used to be you were on one camera with a tally So you knew where your shot was Now there's no shots but everything is is And then they just call the shots They sit in the booth and go like this and they know you know how to edit and they can edit because we have we do it a couple of weeks before um Gregory the way he shoots we have the time he lets us run the scene that we get and you know there's always time while they're setting up they have the light So we come out and the cameraman look to see where we are and we get our marks and then they light it So while they're doing all that we can go with the other actors and run the line run the scene So when we actually get to it we don't feel like a flounder out there like a fly by the seat of our pants We've never

heard it You know because if you're single and you live alone which I am right now you've never heard the dialogue until somebody's telling you the dialogue on TV I had the privilege of doing three episodes of General Hospital Yeah I was gonna save it for afterwards But I wanted to sell when they put me on and there's three cameras I was like where's the director who's telling me what the director in a booth somewhere Some guy with a headphones like oh by the way don't say up for your line I'm like who are you It was like it was wild and they like went really fast That's amazing to hear Gregory is the very opposite He let you run it He takes the time he gets the lighting Right Yeah Well you know he like it and wardrobe like we supply mostly our own ward We have wardrobe people but we mostly bring in what we think is appropriate for the characters And then but Greg he likes like 56 choices Yeah I'm like that I did that That's how we met I created a show I said I I'm not Martin in training Um but I created a show and um cast every every um cast member and uh wrote every episode and um co directed it And uh we we did five episodes of the Charlotte Chronicles which is it's funny it's not a drama Um And and I asked every cast member to show me their wardrobe and this guy I have to throw you out in the he's an incredible actor and you had an original actor and then they replaced him with me like two weeks before the project started um which is how we met Um But I was filming something else during that time but I had worked with the director and I and I read and you wrote it and it was such good writing I was like you know what I just wanna do it just do it Let's like I'll like come off set I'll show it and then let's I'll keep it moving But I don't know if she was aware of that but she was like hey can you like do this can you do that Can you do this Can you do that And I was like I I'm trying my best here I've met you before She was like can you send me your wardrobe Like Gregory likes like options So she's like can you like show me all your wardrobe choices So I just sent her a picture of like all the clothes and like she was like who is this guy Right Jacket shirt shoes Yeah you get that on you just so I can see that It's right for the scene anyway You're great Thank you back to the bay Uh how does he how do you guys get that time I guess because most things are indoors You don't The sun factor is and the time factor Yeah Well sun's outside I know It just depends I mean and and with the COVID thing we eat everything outside you know so all meals are outside Yeah So because we all have to be very careful because everybody has to work We can't afford for somebody to get sick And then everybody shuts down and nothing happens and the location has been paid for and uh oh that's not good you know But so

yeah so it's really good So we do have the time and it's such a luxury I mean to get to run a scene you know two or three or four times depending I'm very flexible So if I'm working with somebody who's like you know I've been with actors Do you wanna run it No I hate that I'm sorry I hate that It's just like this is a team environment Let's make the best that we can do Like run it Like don't don't I sometimes I'll say for at least with this show save it like because we're unscripted obviously Um But you know they like me off the cuff here But yeah I mean like come on if you're an actor like even if you don't want to run it just be there for the other actor to do anything I was asking for a Daniel Day Lewis performance right now just say the word So when it goes you know not only Gregory has control over how I actually have the scene that goes but as the actors you you kind of have to get a certain timing I mean Sophia talks slower Sophia is from the South so I play Sophia and and Gregory's jacket slow down forget the New Jersey thing because I like you I talk fast comes out but I've had to you know so now after doing it all these seasons it's pretty it's very rare every once in a while Say yeah You know and I go oh ok Because I'll have a vision of a scene where she gets like upset and he'll say no no no Sophia doesn't do that Sophia goes here like oh ok So you know I love it So he gave me that I didn't have that you know when I came on he gave me that as the character and I really love it and I appreciate it because a whole different thing for me and a whole different way of approaching a scene just read the words and then let it digest and then you know now after working with certain characters I kind of know the timing right I mean because as as you know the timing sometimes you're with somebody who talks really fast you're with somebody who talks and you kind of have to adjust because otherwise you can't yeah it would be like whoa clutch on you know that kind of thing Yeah Yeah we we love we love having you here and we love binging the bay with everyone Um You can everyone can binge the bay on two right now as we have on our screen Um So so amazing Uh and also we have our interviews from our favorite cast members on um on the bay You can get it on binge the bay dot com So you can tune in to see some of their past episodes with some of our past guests which has been just an absolute pleasure and a joy to learn what goes into making this incredible incredible show that deserves all the awards that it's received and all the nominations that keep coming its way So you can binge the bay with us and go to B the ba dot com and make sure you tune in to me to be the debate to continue the fun Oh my gosh Jackie you are an absolute joy absolute joy And I love having you here and learning about your

story This is your camera Number three over here Pull away let people know how they can get in touch with you and see all the things that you're well I just want to say that our party tonight It's tonight a red carpet big and party for season seven of the bag season eight and the can going to be announced soon is tonight So we're truly you got to celebrate all these incredible actors the incredible incredible writers and everyone and producers and everyone that has been involved We've only just gotten a portion to meet some of some of them but it's magic it's magic It meeting all of you and and meeting everyone has just been an absolute joy and a dream come true for me Thank you Thank you For being on this show Who you are I hope you find the good in your day Spread it to whomever you may But in the meantime make sure get the inches the bay season coming on V right now We'll see you guys tomorrow Have a good night Oh we get to dance I love dancing Is good This is our first this is our first music This is our music from like last summer Yeah Ok Yeah It's bouncy It's catchy Yeah You know a check Yeah And I with great scarce and the
