kitchen I'm waiting Ok this will be good And then I hear holy poopers So she had um she got her Hanukkah bush It was massive It was decorated with um you decorated it well yeah Jewish Jewish ornaments obviously Star Wars ornaments obviously uh store in that Uh The business is uh they they part adults oriented toys And so I thought what else would be good on a Christmas show So I had much of that stuff hanging as well for sure So we had friends who came over and you know they're looking at it Is that it And I let them know is that what I think it is Oh no It's it's batteries you can turn it on ornaments So you've got Star Wars you've got Christmas you've got Jewish Um I think I put something in there for Christmas and then we have hanging which could be a consolation prize to take home once a tree is done There you go crazy You can't So that was um that's those rages that she gets in the devious patience It's great It's great because rather than rubbing someone's face in it you just get to be smug more Please take us a little smirk Maybe a little look I can see why she married you um all the time So I inadvertently have a very random education as I pointed out to your passions My passion is war politics patriotism and music war politics music war politics politics um patriotism and music And the reason I I throw patriotism there is when I was about 15 I went to DC for some U CDC I just remember being struck by how people I was in the library of Congress I was in the Supreme Court and it just moved me so much that bureaucratic red tape but they still love the country so much and it's everywhere and it wasn't for any other intention just for them and they loved it And so that really just made me beyond giddy I ended up being congressional page and I work for who they were the Government Affairs committee They were huge congressmen tenured They'd be kind of up there with Adam Schiff right now if you're looking at where they were So they were they were fantastic And so a congressional page So houses of Congress And so that was fantastic And by the way where the pages live is an old mortuary What were you doing Working in both Oh because you can go back and forth between the Senate and the Congress because you're working 222 congressmen and then they had their kind of go back and forth corresponding underneath That's where I met John Glenn with my mom and my brother and my mom was like oh guys this is John Glenn We were super little and uh three moon three times and my brother was when he was like a little guy and then he you know ultimately went back um which I thought was uh I always attributed to my brother Andrew for being a little prick that he was going to go back to space But I thought that was so cool We would go to DC I mean he wanted to be an

astronaut but he was afraid of flying I just want to get back on top of means believing in our government believing in the constitution And so for instance um again I went to education so they understand what patriotism comes into this I went to the school first of all it's far the school from my family and the only reason I chose it was if I grew up in this city I'd always be so and so so ok when I was in high school and it was named after me for something I had done and when they introduced me they were named after me they let everyone know this is so and so's son and there was just something to get cracked in my buddy Yeah it was an old lady exorcism So I went home and I was looking at all the schools I got into and for this one geographically DC So the name of the school is the Elliott School of International Affairs It's a consortium of Georgetown George Washington and Johns Hopkins And then you do you have to be abroad So it's a long program It's a very elite program They take very few people How long was it It's supposed to be six years I believe we did it well because there were only six of us that basically finished out of 53 I think Yeah it's because you get burned out We've got three different campuses and then very intense and most of us had to go through which has burned people out as well So I mean when I was there I was interning at the World Bank and the IMF and that was horrible And I was brought up on ethnic charges for being ignorant of my heritage which is amusing because I was this account as an intern um \$25 million to the uh to Africa to the Ivory Coast They never did anything It was just sitting in a checking account of course not even aggregating anything And that was just mind boling to me All they want to know is who donated it not what we should do with it So I delivered the report to the guy who requested it and he comes at me in Spanish and I answer this way and again Spanish I answer this way and again Spanish answer this way and he wants no no I know it but I'm Jew and he looks at me No I'm Latino I know fellow Latinos Your complexion your hair you're Latino And I just OK cool Have a good one man and I walked out and I came back the next day and on my desk I was brought up on charges for being ignorant of my cultural heritage nonexistent cultural Oh it was spectacular I have it a frame somewhere back to the patriotism patriotism So the um it's all the uh international school So I've got um four double degrees in international politics international uh economics international politics Yeah because the university black University So uh double majors in uh no not at all Um uh International Affairs International uh economics or politics finished at the Sorbonne Um and CIA that kind of stuff And I realized that I could actually do more good because my dad was

so intent on me getting to the CIA because they recruited me left and right And then dad if I did that you'd get something that I was dead And I would never see my family again because I would not be here and you might still be alive I would be but they would never see me again And that would be the reason for me not pursuing that path But I decided at that point that I can do more good seen the bureaucratic red tape And I realized so I was given and this is humility Actually I I was born with a plethora of gifts that just keep um exponentially increasing Um And it's I was put here to do something to make the world a better place that much I know um how and where and when I do it whenever I can But it's these gifts that I have my ability to kind of move in any circle be anybody connect on every level because I do believe that there is that experience It's something you have to learn from but you do a takeaway and you learn what you don't want to do Um Did you always have this mind that my phone ever since you were a little guy from your parents or just like innately my grandparents Awesome What about your grandfather that had made you have this experience He died in 1995 just so you understand people still come up to me to this day letting you know how he changed their life Wow So he's been dead since 1995 And and and please let me know what your about your grandfather Because I don't know So he was the ultimate renaissance man um lawyer businessman uh real estate magnate Secret Colonel in the Hazarat which is the uh would have fishing trips and my mother would have his friends see his friends come at you know three in the morning to the house and he was sending guns to Israel And so he became an honorary colonel He was also an ambassador for you know a small stint to either Belgium or Luxembourg I mean there's not anything this man didn't do and he was beyond brilliant and the kindest soul you've ever met in your entire life But he's the toughest mother ever Usually they are the kinder they are the tougher a very good let me know after he wants to meet and be behind the school yard at 3 60 Yeah Yeah Big big heart tough outer outer shell Yeah So he was and he was also um an artist a sculptor and my grandmother was a spectacular artist whose pantheon of art expanded you know 50 60 years for 70 years Um It's either oh wow you get it from her Yeah o'clock in the afternoon So it was a different situation Um But we always knew and all my friends knew when we get home after um having a salubrious night of live we get on the phone and we drunk dial her and she'd be in her studio and she'd be painting blasting music and she was just so whimsical and brilliant By the way beyond brilliant Both were um and she saw the beauty and everything I got dispatched to um get my grandmother

Yeah Where are you And um I found her in the shower with a sketchbook and she she was sketching the veins of the travertine in the marble She's found fascinating in depth Um huge um beyond fascinating people Incredible incredible And so I so when I could I would fly back every two weeks to have dinner with my grandmother and then fly back out wherever I was Um Yeah and it was just one of these things and one of my going away parties it was at this uh place in Hollywood and I think my friends put together about 1500 people came to this thing and the star was my grandmother 16 layer mink fur coat That's always for color Yeah Yeah And my friends all fell in love with her Of course I mean it was how do you know And she's stunning Um We only have a couple of minutes with the show but I hope because we're so fascinated Um uh I I wanna pull you away I got what I got and and he gave me a two with his hands I'm not coming up with this I would I wouldn't be you know I wouldn't be doing tell people how they can connect with you and and find more and so fun right now Yeah Um Well that's I'm just getting go ahead You can find me I run a clinic down a free clinic down in uh and we actually do fights and then we also harvest their organs when they're done But you can reach me at uh I'll give you just this address It's hash underscore L as in V as in victorious at yahoo dot com Lose your attention And if you want I can give you my 100 number But since I know all those people so well I'll let you know that I'll waive the first four minutes 4 95 petrol So that's probably the best way to get on Got a you're hilarious Um your day if you want to find out your door or like you know a warehouse make sure you contact him and for many other reasons So you been wonderful awesome news friends We'll see you guys got to make sure I'll see you then Bye Oh my God you're hilarious I can't stop laughing There's so much there's so much I do Well the thing is you bring back to patriotism All I am is and I would always circle back I thought you were going to that's why I was like I was trying to make sure too because we were time limited But yeah so all the points are they do have yeah I got the fingers and I was like oh decrease that a a love yeah Guess And he's an earth
