And welcome back to Good day Today is Tuesday You're tuning October 25th 2022 We have a very special guest but if you are just meeting us for the very first time I'm Michelle La Ramirez I'm Kyle Trueblood I just remember my last my last name my middle name said me too It's a singing day a day It is a singing day Do you have with us Mr Daniel Ha Hey guys Thank you Thank you for having us Yes please Ok please That's too much Too much No seriously Calm down there Calm down out there Thank you for having me I really appreciate being here Yes I've been watching a little bit of the show You guys are awesome I'm glad you enjoyed it And uh so yes I think uh if you get some oatmeal and you heat it up I think that's kind of breakfast cereal but could be soup cereal and so 100% that chef had No no idea what he's talking about That's my that's my question You make fun of that question The soup I like It's a ridiculous question She's trying to it's just a natural it's just natural with us So glad it's no I'll try to be natural to you guys are part of the show over here Nice jacket But is that a dig or No That's a good thing Um I think it came from China to be honest with you That's it It's Amazon Actually there's an Amazon How about that It's an Amazon jacket I don't think the brand is even on there but it's Amazon and it's just made in China That's all I can tell you fancy stuff and like looking for a jean jacket that fit well and I went to all the little consignment shops It's a little too loose from the eighties and this right this one's snug enough you know there it is finally fits my uh European shoulders like deal with this kind of thing Yeah Yeah I'm a bill you know I'm not I do have shoulders I mean I don't have the like the you know I'm like an H and M off the rack guy I like pop right on It's like I don't need to tailor if it's like a 39 or 40 I'm like right there Right I actually go with like the 40 regular or small and then it it's actually perfectly Yeah something like that Yeah Usually regular Yeah Yeah we'll talk about your hair later and your perfect hair But thank you sir Yeah sure We can talk about singing I I grew up doing singing I grew up doing musical theater and my parents are musicians I grew up doing concerts with my family since I was a little kid And my sister who was an o is an opera singer My dad sang at the Met for years and uh he's a he's a tenor one of the best in my he's in his seventies but he's one of the best in my opinion even though he had kids and your life changes when you have Children and that kind of you know shapes the way you uh you have a career sometimes But he still sings He sings at churches and he's like he's always like God It was

amazing today I was amazing They got up and cheered him like in church He's like yeah they cheered I was like good for you man Good for you So that's kind of my upbringing is musical Uh So that's where I started my life You got Norwalk Connecticut My mom's name and my mother's name is Maryann Just so you know my middle name is Brunner Bruer It's a German descent Uh It would probably have been like Bruer or something like that you know whatever but it's Brumer and uh my mother's maiden name So that's kind of how that's me Now you get it That's it Those are the facts the facts of life Where did acting swing into the acting swung in with when I was really young I started a community theater called Crystal Theater which was amazing The excuse me No I started in that I didn't start you gotta watch every word She's good She's Gheryl I started my acting career in Crystal Theater which just bragged about listening And then the next the next thing was wait what did you say The biggest thing in relationships is communication communication And if you don't listen to your partner man I'll tell you what anyway what we we have this game called hearing thing 00 sorry sorry sorry Yeah we were always like because so many people are like are you guys dating Are you married I'm like we're not dating He's my brother from another I need this for my sister My my blood sister we go out and shoot pool together and she was like the person you never saw it coming because I guess women in pool don't make sense But she actually is a bad ass pool And they were like is this your girlfriend And I was like so no I didn't get to use a pad You gotta get me a paddle Um So you started your acting career at six Yes Very even younger Probably five But but I started with it was called Crystal Theater It was Cheryl Ky and her sister started this amazing program in Norwalk Connecticut And I did all these musicals original musicals from them A lot of them were uh uh some based on uh folk tales and things like this But one was the snow queen If you remember that as a Hans Christian Anderson I I play this character named Kai and Kai and I but Kay probably Kyle probably doesn't come out on stage and forget his lines when he's 67 I I'm sure if it happened I go on stage I have a body mic and as I'm walking off stage I screwed up the whole song I repeated one verse over and over and over and I knew I couldn't get it I walk off stage I'm like maybe eight years old at this time And I have this body mic when I go backstage and before I'm making the change a quick change I'm not gonna curse here But I said what the oh I kept swearing over Oh I was eight but I was yeah I was swearing and it's just I could hear it echoing through the whole auditorium Oh my God I was like oh great And all the

parents were there and they're probably like you're not hanging out with Daniel Hall anymore That's it So anyway that that's my my was not a church This is the Crystal theater thing It it was done in a church To be honest with you though We did them in very small like community like basements of schools and things like that But we were kids I I haven't come that much far away and apparently was a brutal dude He was a real tough guy you know at five that you wanna do this to be an actor No I think I wanted to be a musician And uh by the time I was in high school I I picked up the guitar a little bit and I got got a little fender stratocaster Squire So it wasn't like the the expensive one But I played that for a while and I I got to play like Jimi Hendry stuff like fire and and like Purple Haze and things like this Jimmy I now can play a little better because actually I dated this this wonderful guitar player She's a great person great amazing musician and a very sweet woman and she taught me she got me and she was a sweet TV guest She was actually uh friends with Tammy who has hosted other shows And um she kind of sparked that again for me So I've been playing a lot more I got call again It takes time to build us up But I'm finally back in that and I've been playing a lot of guitar Yeah I love how uh people like and relationships can help inspire I know there's pain sometimes Uh I think all the time I think there's usually reason I think there's like always reasons for why we meet people and I always think it's for inspiration and for our what did I say Every person is a chain in their golden link of our good Yeah like every person you meet like a link didn't I say that First episode second episode you said something about a golden chain chain Yeah You know but it's OK Uh a golden chain but just with it Yeah I did That's cool I'm happy that she inspired you to you know like you're saying that no matter how how the relationship goes or what happens within the relationship it teaches you to look at yourself hopefully as well You look at yourself you look at what how you what your job was and and what your shortcomings were in the relationship or not And and everyone is a is a stepping stone to something else or you never know you never know you never know Uh What So you're producing now I'm producing Yeah I I have acted most of my career and producing has always been something I was interested in But I was like man how do you wear that hat along with starring in a thing So this film was handed to me by a director who I met 10 years ago at the Roosevelt when I used to Barten I used to bar tend there And uh he came in and he just started taking pictures of me sitting across the bar and I was like what is this guy A little creepy and then he's like No no he's like I'm a director and he had an

Ascot on a little hat and I was like I was like I mean next thing you know he's like I gotta get a hotel room upstairs No no no But um but he was very cool with me He was so cool Uh Rupert was awesome and he's like no I actually he actually booked me on a job later So he was actually a director Um And uh he's the years later they sent me the script through a mutual friend of ours and she says you know do you want to play this role And I said yeah but what's happening with the script And he's like oh we tried producing it 10 years ago I just didn't get traction And I said I love this story I love the bones of the script and I why don't I give it a shot And I said I don't think I wanna act and I want to produce it And so I kind of helped to rewrite it a little bit and tweak it just to make it more marketable It was 10 years old And I think it was even the idea the concept came from way before that So we bumped it up made it more marketable made it a little more of a fast paced kind of page turner And now it's in a place where it's getting traction Um It takes a long time to produce something Hello Is that a guy with money over there What is that The guy is gonna give us money for the film What are they doing over there It's like you're getting calls that are like we want to produce we want to give money So long story short the film basically we've had uh Liam Neeson's read It loved it wasn't right for him Uh Jim Sheridan was interested in directing directed my yeah I don't think he was ready to play grandfather roles because he doesn't kick anybody's ass in this You know he's not beating anybody up It's more of like a feel good redemption story Um where you're basically you're rescuing greyhounds Um And at the end of the film you find out that you you find hope in sometimes the most unique places you you don't expect to look for it And that's kind of the movie Liam's like well where do I kick somebody's butt like well yeah Yeah So we may go back to him with a little tweak just to kind of you know if I really want Liam Neeson he's just I'll throw one in maybe like have like kick someone out of the house he kicks him out of the house maybe a dog fight Hi Tim Where is she on the on the chat Hi Tammy how are you I miss you Tammy These guys are doing an incredible job though but he is he is Steven Seagal I think he's actually a bit more badass Steven Sea is a badass Don't don't ever question that I'm not going to see you in a dark alley because you will kick my butt with your like little bench and he's kind of doing a lot of like uh not jujitsu Yeah Well he doesn't seem like he has to move much but he still throws the guy through the wall Like anyway I digress but here we go So um where are you in the producing stages where we are right now God you know it's funny you get you think you're like oh we're at the gate we're

about to kick through the door and then you're like oh the director's schedule doesn't work and then you're like oh the financing starts going away over there because the director was the financing and then you go to get the actors and you have your Liam Neeson connection and then you go to we had Timothy Dalton who was very interested in this and he's another you know James Bond from the I think he was in the eighties Um great guy Really sweet Loves this story Um he was an IC M client before they got bought I think just recently IC M got bought by CAA and I don't remember CAA I think became this WME is already the the big guys and then I think IC M got bought and it's now like three different agencies So we kind of waited till the dust cleared on that We're gonna probably circle back and see what's going on over there Everything's in the air until it's not And then even then you're like what you guys are at home are hearing is the business This is the business is the business They're really just giving us a clear example of how complicated it really is based on time sequencing let alone the creativity and finding it It's also like sequencing up the time Yes Yes Same with relationships might be the right person wrong time or the right time wrong person And then that's how films are it's the same thing And right now I think this movie needs to be made because of the way the world is right now We need something that kind of let's what are people missing in their lives mostly during the pandemic was family You didn't get to see them or someone was sick and they were actually let's say immuno compromised and you couldn't go be with them And so this movie lets you go back to that in the nostalgia of family And one of our taglines in the beginning on the the cover art is uh when life's odds are stacked against you it takes family to bring your heart home And that's kind of where we want to bring the that's what we need to bring back to the world man with every story I thank you I think it translates good and we're no no not to speak over I'm just saying we're losing that in a way It's good to bring that back We are We are And it's it's a you know listen social media is a great tool It's a wonderful tool Um But it's also a double edged sword and I think people lose sight of what's really important and it's good to really like reflect on that stuff So that's good Yeah that's good We love we we're like batting 1000 and bringing on creators that are not just creating but they have a clear line to helping out the world You know what as much as we can I mean it's all good I sorry go ahead I was just saying we all have platforms and you guys are doing that here you know it doesn't matter how big it is I mean if you're if you're Tom Cruise sure you have a bit of a bigger platform So anyway can wait for that

next one coming out to God He the next uh mission impossible on another plane this time He doesn't have any just with his leg Uh What is it about Do you like to you know he the man surviving just on male men alone I mean yes yes I mean I did watch Top Gun with AAA Lady and she was incredibly excited She love she's also this is the guitar player She loves uh she loves planes and not like not like new planes but like classic warbirds and like she gets in all that stuff The mustang Um so my point is she loved watching that because they threw in that old the old fighters from the original and like she likes even more older things But my I I gotta say there are some women out there who can really take a she's a she's a she's a vintage gal but there's some women out there who definitely are interested in in in Tom Cruise because of the planes and all that stuff Yeah I mean not for you What what does it for you What movie star does it for you if I don't mind asking you questions But uh gosh I don't know that Oh he does it for a lot of girls I don't know it for me I'm not I don't know Like no no no I know too much about Leo personally Oh didn't you have to sign an ND A If that was like I was gonna say I just know about like it's just like not I don't know it's like just pick a star Chris Pratt Ok And he's he's approachable Chris Pratt is very approachable Like well I don't know him but like if I were to think of like he strikes me as a nice guy nice guy He's very approachable He was the funny guy He was you know kind of like the best friend and now he's like the tough you know movie star I liked him in parks and rec more though because he was more likable there than he funny and soft Kyle This is something we need to take with us Is that a funny guy goes miles beyond a six pack I'm not kidding I mean not the six pack of drink But yeah Yeah that's it That's it She's laughing with you guys I know you guys are brothers or sisters from you guys You guys keep do you guys do well together You guys have a good rapport that Hold on hold on There you go That's all you need right now There you go Yes Yes Yes No I'm very overprotective of my friend Um But uh no we have really great uh chemistry we met on a show that I created during um 2020 towards the end of 2020 2020 one called the Charlotte Chronicles and he was supposed to he was never supposed to be in this I guess he ultimately was and the guy that was supposed to pay the guy that I keep running into my love interest Um got really long dreads and um because I wasn't paying anyone other than production I was like this is not gonna work because I can't tell him to cut his hair and it just didn't work like a commitment I mean a huge commitment It went from like Kyle to dread It was like long like Beyonce and like he did it in weeks and uh so the director

was like Michelle don't worry Uh we have a guy like he'll be perfect And I was like I don't know And then here's a clip from a couple of years ago of how we met actually Met 0406 Yes So you like dogs I love dogs I just adopted a dog actually Yeah Yeah The little one right Oh you noticed me I mean you notice Charlotte Yeah I mean how could I forgot such a cute face Hi I'm Michael And this is Sara Michelle I never forget a cute face Of course you're not gonna go out in public with that on are you girl you gotta tell Charlotte to wait that Hey how's it going Good good great Have a good night You too beautiful Anyway that's how it all works out And then I interviewed him on a show that I created called Dream on Where to back up I also wasn't supposed to play the role not only because she had me replaced but then she was like well she replaced them and she auditioned to me and I didn't nail the audition She's the guy He's not edgy enough Kyle's not edgy enough Come on live on the edge It just wasn't it just didn't I don't know it just didn't feel right But then you know it's called acting Yeah No no no no I know your audition Like I didn't get it Like I wasn't feeling it Yeah Well no it wasn't even the audition It was after the audition because I kept the camera rolling and kissed my dog and she was like oh he's too sweet You ruined it after the fact And I was like the lines were done and by the way it turned out really really great You were awesome in it And um our uh our uh major screen debut is on the 19th of November So thank you Thank you Thank you everybody Please go check out the uh the name of the Charlotte Chronicles Please check this out It's an amazing film series web series of course it might be a film um next year Who knows Um But yeah it will be at the Regal Theater uh at L A live DC P or like got a trans I don't keep me posted an invitation Uh DC P Oh I I have to look at my phone It's like directoral Oh it's like uh digital cinema Uh You can like Alexa What does DC P stand for I get all kinds of answers right I like that She's not working today I don't think Alexa what does DC P stand for Alexa Alexa Alexa What does DC P mean No no not that not that Alexa Alexa Hold it Alexa just hutch your mouth Alexa Ok Maybe we'll just we'll just Google that I mean years of the Yeah Yeah Yeah Wow that'd be like the movie Friday if you ever wanted to know what it is in digital set up package Ok I was like oh cool How much is that gonna cost like a poster and a trailer and a movie and all that Right And the bios No that's just getting it on um a 70 ft screen and uh 774 the package you got to do like your audio design all that stuff So basically you have to take what your file and then make it like like huge We we yeah I think of how big your face is with that mask on the mask like 10 ft wide and I take out my

phone and just be like yeah I can't wait I I hopefully I'm free to see that You're more than welcome to come We see Kyle's Edgy performance We'll see if it we're only playing the first two episodes of it though Yeah that's good I'm not sure which episode I'm in Probably none of those but they blur together is like a 35 minute short to me is what it felt like the way we where we shot it and then they cut it up afterwards into like episodes which works well Yeah that's I think how you should do it I watch it What episode you're in it Oh my God It's ok He's busy He's busy I get it I get it You're a series regular You're a he is a man that he is the first episode It's like whatever it's it's all good It's all good Yeah Yeah Yeah Uh so what do you like more singing or uh acting or pro you know if I could do all three in a movie it'd be pretty cool Um but I what do I like more I really do I love performing There's something really great about even this feels kind of like a live it is live but like you know if you had a big studio audience it'd be rude and let's hire some people But that feeling of the the immediate gratification is something that you get as an athlete as a musician as a in a play But it's different because they can't like you're not able to break that fourth wall the same you can with with music So music can be a lot of fun because you can interact with the audience Um so God there's something really magic about performing live as a musician but um making movies because you get to travel you get to you get to show people a very specific story through the lens of your director's vision and show them what to look at with music They can kind of drift and watch the drummer for a while or watch whoever else is on the stage you get to show them No no this is what you're going to be watching and this is how I want you to experience this and then you come to it from your own perspective But yeah so there's I think it's a mix between music and film What genre do you like to stay in or just like anything II I think comedy is really hard I've done some I love it I think it's fun to watch for me as an actor It scares me Uh but I guess it's to be funny you can't try to be funny Why does comedy scare you Well because you I think you naturally are funny So you I think you naturally come in Yeah I'm kind of funny and it works it's charm it's charming and funny A lot of people try to be funny and it's it's very hard because it's timing that I think you innately either have or you don't you can study with all the coaches and if some people just don't they're not funny and some people and man if you can be a pretty woman or an attractive man or what what is what I don't even know what's PC with woman being attractive as well Um but my point is my point is if you're funny and attractive then you're a comedy star Yeah Or or you

know Yeah I hate the word I hate any of this stuff but that's the business It really is I had a casting director say to me hey man you're you're a handsome guy But God if you can be funny you'd kill it And I was like am I funny She's like well you know you're you're charming and I was like well not funny She's like not that funny I was like you can be funny I think so many people tell me that I wasn't funny but you can you can't be funny No no no you can't be funny if you wanna be funny that you just are I think we're all funny Like we're we're funny in certain ways Yeah Yeah Some people are funny Some people aren't that right I mean ii I can see how that is because I don't naturally gravitate towards drama Like that's not I do I think I think I don't know why this is I think this is a this is a a bit of a topic the Doer show Have you guys watched this It's a lot of fun but it's a little bit of a sort of disturbed perverse thing that people like to watch this It's like watching a car accident You can't look away It's so disturbing and you kind of question your own you know my psychology Um but I love dark roles where you because you can't you can't do that stuff in real life Nobody's gonna do any of that stuff But to get to dive into your psychosis your darkness is kind of a fun thing to get to do because it's safe to do it there Yeah When you have when you have everyone has weird thoughts in their life you're walking down the street and you're like that guy let's say somebody flips you off for no reason You kind of just like oh I wanna punch him You don't get to do that stuff in real life But in the in acting you know like are people hit No he gets like bullied and then he goes and does some I'm not that that's a fantasy for anybody Hopefully not We're not having fantasies like that But my point is to play dark things is a lot of fun to do because you get to explore parts of your psyche that you you can't do in real life So in a safe space in a safe place for a good cause Yeah Yeah Yeah Uh I I tend to gravitate towards the I started out in New York doing comedy sketch on Broadway So talking about comedy and making people try to get a uh New York crowd to laugh is a whole different thing Like yeah show me your fun Exactly They're like yeah Yeah Yeah you're funny OK Go ahead Go ahead You you ever play at the slipper room in New York When were you there Lower East Side I was on eighth and 36th at the American National are legit theaters I was talking about like a lounge But that's awesome man Congrats on over there Very cool But no to answer your question I do like lean towards the dramatic more I don't know why But yeah Yeah Who knows I don't know why II I don't have like a superficial answer for that You want to explore those sites I didn't want to take your answer It was a good answer I also like it because you get to you get to feel like you tell stories that are real Part of the reason I walked away not walked away but moved away from musical theater is you don't break out in a song that often I mean you might I feel like nothing wrong with it This was a real good clam bake I'm awfully proud you came Yeah we're not It's a little weird if I back back up there I was like so that was from Carousel if anyone remembers that old classic But uh anyway anyway any time you guys want to break out a song I can be funny I guess I like to be funny You gotta gotta find your own Like I use my cynicism in a way I think you have like a very quick dark wit can be really funny You're like bubbly which is also funny but they're all different types of funny The bubbly comes from probably insecurity which is really fun No I'm not kidding This is what I feel like the more comedy people put out usually is because they're they're maybe slightly insecure about the moment or not or they're just good at it But for me it comes from a place of usually like a slight insecurity I'll make something funny to to take the attention off So I think that's something I've done in my life Good sorry piggyback off of that I definitely have like find the funny in very awkward situations and that's probably where that is where like I was at a funeral and I just started cracking up That's really bad I didn't know how to like it was like the only thing that was like that felt natural in the moment because I was just like I just can't do it I actually cried later but like 10 years ago my friend got his car towed and I just started like laughing about it and he was like why are you laughing I was like I don't know I don't know I it's yeah like who gets their car towed at 2 a.m. There's a truck service now anyway Is it is it really it doesn't feel right Like no they're gone I guess that's where comedy lies Right And the breaking up logic you're asking somebody who doesn't want to play comedy We're dissecting it Oh you do Oh I worked on a show it's a very small role but there are no small roles Right There are no I played Jamie Presley's Date boyfriend on I hate my teenage daughter a few years back The show was great It didn't make a long run but it did what it did But that written by my name is Earl the creator I remember the name right now I'll look into it Yeah I mean we'll come back but I just remember sitting I was not the funny I was the straight man in the scene and I remember she came on and her girlfriend comes in and they're doing this whole bit and I'm just going like yeah so I'm having a date and she's like what you got you got an older brother you got a cute brother or something like that I like and I'm supposed to be like um this is all the laugh is on them and I'm just so the director literally comes over He's like you're just a you're just a cute guy and you're just the straight man Don't do

anything Oh great Thank you I can do this now I got my sweaty hands going away and I got a hammer right I guess that's what it is too You go to a com you ever go to a comedy stand up and you can tell that the the stand up comedian is searching for the laughs and then you're like oh well I can't laugh now because now I feel like I'm doing you a favor man with acting in general I find like if the person up there is comfortable it makes you comfortable and then you enjoy the performance If you're like oh God they might mess this up Oh my Oh God You feel bad for it's impossible to watch And it's really not You won't laugh Yeah Yeah That this has been comfortable by the way you're awesome too Um we have games If you're down to play a game I love games We have a couple of games I need more game night friends So we um we have pencil nose which is you put uh a glasses on your face and you we have to try to guess what you're drawing with your nose We have hearing things where you put it on and uh you have to guess what we're trying to say and you have voice like voices in the headphones or you can play Red Flags which is the game that I kind of came up with And it's like we get to learn each other about each other whether we're all dating or not dating Um you can figure out I'm not gonna throw anybody under the bus But Andy the producer said you not kidding But uh but uh I I did hear I did hear there was a great game called Red Flags prior to this and if we have time to squeeze to We can do short versions of each Get a red flag by you Kyle You grab a red flag for me Thank you Thank you Thanks This is my idea I do not make these This is my idea So my brain my brain works It looks like I made them Um My brain literally works like uh ideas just come I'm getting to sorry let's get Yeah Yeah About yourself Yeah She talks about her first name is only on the poster I I'm having fun to the show now Now you have fun because it's on the opposite side I get it I get it Ok So here here are the red flags Um Yeah we're not like there's plenty of red flags out there My friend there's enough I'm sure we actually had a couple Yeah there's I mean there's six Did you No I did not Did you make anything in your I made this show that I cast Kyle Kyle on the street the Charlotte Chronicle Dream on And uh many many other things so way bigger things than the cards and the flag So these are there are no small ok Uh You get to pick a card and you just read it and uh we'll decide whether or not it's a reflect it Uh They uh so farts every time they kiss you There you go That's why you do Now do you say yes that's a red flag or not Yeah you say it's a red flag or not a red flag We do Do you hear something You gotta let it then farts every time they kiss you and you feel nauseous from the scent that

OK a lot of obvious red flag cards It's definitely a red flag if they have I BS or something But you know you know listen but actually you know what trots I BS everyone's got an issue It's not it's not it's not about black for me if you have an I BS um keep it to yourself but don't let it go So if she parts every time she kisses you you're cool No no no that's not I BS That's a that's a that's an issue That's something else That's all No no no Just just don't look at them You're still a Kyle is cherry picking the flags I I don't just don't go through them Just pick one That's how we're playing it now He's always supposed to play this controlling over here He calls me controlling Are you not You screamed at me from the outside opinion It looks like you're both controlling So that's great He still calls you controlling I I understand that As long as we take two this is a red flag it takes two to tango You guys brings their mom to their first date Yeah man I'm not raising I'm raising it Sorry It depends Where where is the date and have we talked before Like did we No 1st 1st date brings the mom for me Yeah Yeah Yeah Well why not I know I wanna see uh I wanna see what's going on over there So hold on a second Does it matter if it's a guy or a girl I know this is gonna sound like we're dealing with sex but it does bring his mom You're like maybe that's yeah because men are supposed to be talking a woman bringing a mom could be cute could be cute that I I get that but I think she's referring to a man I don't know man Um So yeah I get why she might I I'm doing that just because I want to get to know the person I think the mom's gonna be I'll be not myself because the mother will be trying to please Yeah parents love me though So I'll be like I'm like that's not a red flag for me with the mom That's a red flag Every parent loves you My dad was funny My dad my dad was on the east coast and he was like is that Kyle the one that thinks that every parent loves him Yeah because he loves me He sure sure Jealous of your pet Where's your flag Uh I wanna see what everyone else So so if I had a pet you were dating me and and you were jealous of my pet is that what you're saying Ok Yeah I mean but like does the person like do you get to talk it out like leave my dog alone Do you have a dog I have a I have a girl husky He's in love with her Does he come in the purse I mean Huskies are big but do you have a big man purse You can put her in there He carries her That's a black guy My my thing is I love his his dog in there still Yeah daugg er you make a shirt make a t-shirt because you can't really hear it until you see it And I do have a thing though I have a thing if a if a person a woman who I've dated has a dog it's like it's like there in intimate moments if it's there in every moment and they say things like he was here first and you're like can we just put it Well

that when she's with the dog she was 12 this girl specifically she was like she was here first and I was like I was never I was just all right So we were we were just kissing let's say and the dog's in there and I felt someone kissing my ear and I was like does she have two mouths Yeah Yeah And the dog's kissing my ear and I was like I said no no can we just can we just the dog just for now just for like a few minutes Just Yep Yep So personal space Yeah that's unsanitary sanitation We gotta keep it keep it out there Moving on Right Moving moving on Is this me OK Ok See how he just grabbed the top I heard you scream the first time that this one's gonna be tricky for you guys I think um live tweets your entire date Oh ok Because I figured you guys might want to be live live Love it Yeah so not that I wouldn't I don't tweet uh live streams their entire date Forget the tweet Take the take the branding of it The date is it is the first day second day third day That don't no I don't No no But the uh go ahead It's not let's not do it Another the producers are uh wanting to stir the pot a little bit I like it We're told to refrain from our all of our dating lives Well um uh the producer asked you to talk about your previous dating lives Is it a red flag Yeah Oh I see for me I ever since I was super little I love to document like all the time This is gonna sound so weird because it is But your brother always is like you gotta film that Why are you filming that I'm like five years from now You're gonna wanna see this and he was like that's not true And I was like yes you are So I actually saw this on um Instagram and thought it was really really really cute Uh this couple uh I know them and directly I'm not like super close with them but the uh they're now married and he filmed their first date when he like went to go pick her up and it was so so cute He didn't film the whole date but he was like like on my way to pick up Abby and she answered the door and she's like hi And he's like you already have a good time She's like yeah I don't think they filmed anything else I'm not that I know of And anyway they're married now and um his post on Instagram on the day they got married was uh two years ago today This uh this happened and it was really really uh endearing to me uh in retrospect it's super endearing on the moment You might have been like whoa whoa you marry that person Hopefully you end up marrying the person I mean if the person was like do you want to I'd be like yeah Yes because I love filming I just I love it Well if you had found you it would have been perfect Right Yeah As long as I'm ready for it put the put the phone away Ok How do you feel about that at the table That's sorry to take it But as you're having dinner Should the phones be even out on the table Even if they're faced down should they be like out of sight I'm ok with them on the

table What if there's an emergency Ok If you have a dog if you got a dog or a lot of a lot a dog uh a lot of what I do is very much tied to uh communication So whether it's like work or like my dad like I just like to have it out just in case Fair enough Fair enough But what about your Yeah I'm gonna I'm gonna get it off the table I had it out there I did that and just sometimes you find yourself even if it's not doing anything you kind of you look at it or let's say it lights up if you have the notifications coming up on the screen like oh what's this You know And then it's like what if it's like work and then you then you're done then the date's done You're like oh good I like to check it out If you go on a hike Do you ever leave it in the car Yeah Yeah So I just do them to be off the grid for like an hour and a half Boom I'm out Yeah My phones on silent all the time It's good But do you have an Apple Watch I wanna be that I still wanna be that person but I'm the kind of person That's like what if it is an emergency Like who like and it was just like me and that person like who do I like What do I do if you're expecting maybe someone's going to the hospital and you know that and then you keep it out but you don't have to be the emergency savior Every time there's another friend I'm just saying at night I turn my phone on silent mode but I do set a few people in my life like my parents or let's say a significant other where if they call twice in a row within a minute it rings through But other than that I'm like I'm sleeping man You have an emergency call Somebody else I didn't even know you could do that Yeah Yeah I didn't And you're on the you're on the list you call you call through it's coming through man I'll be like and he's calling I called I called once and he was like I don't I don't talk on the phone He doesn't I don't think I've ever talked to him on the phone I don't think anyone's ever talked to you on the phone other than me No I talked to a lot of people on the phone I was trying to can I make a red flag card in my head here Ok So uh before your first date you've only texted the guy calls you or the girl calls you you Ok That's not a like phone calls leaving messages on your voicemail A message not to one He calls you don't pick up He leaves you like hey looking forward to the date tonight I just wanna know uh if you want me to pick you up All right Talk to you later Love me too That's if you're uh you know listen I'm not saying you guys are older but we are not 22 And if you go on a date with somebody who's in their twenties they're gonna be freaked out Probably Right Because they're gonna be like what is that Yeah And they don't even know how to check their voice Here's one uh online dating you match you've been talking for two weeks and she goes I wanna facetime you before we meet up isn't online dating like facetiming

anyway Doing the whole like you see each other and back and forth You don't need to facetime me Yeah like they want to see that you real ok in the world of I'm sure you guys have dealt with this But let's say somebody reaches out to you on Instagram and they're like hey hey this is me and they send you a picture and like hi I love you so much Let's say you're a fan of yours or something like that And they smile I don't believe that's who the person is half the time because I don't I mean let's say you've done a bit of a TV show and they're fans of that show and they're like hey I love Scott Granger This is me Send me a picture of you in a hat or something I'm like no I said I don't think that's you I once in a blue moon I did especially when I first when I was first on the show when I first was on Young and The Restless I was kind of like intrigued by this star Oh man I I've got people who I don't know reaching out And this one time this woman said something like hey I'd love to meet you sometime I was like this girl is pretty I was single I was like no I'm kidding But it it's just a thing like it wasn't even young and the restless it was post young and the restless And I said to her I said is this even you And she goes what You don't believe me I said I don't believe you Yeah And I said send me a picture of you holding a baseball cap in your right hand and uh touching your nose and she's like oh you don't believe it's me And then her account got deleted It is There it is And I said well well ha ha Yeah Baseball cap touching the make them do something that's like not they can't find a stock image somewhere Yeah Yeah Touch your right eyebrow right eyebrow You know something weird It's weird Well she had she was interested in dating me and I thought she was a sweet person and I was like this is weird out there Oh God Yeah It's hard to trust anymore It's hard to trust this world All right on to something more fun Yeah You pick six cards Not me It calls their pets their Children I love it I can't I don't like that Yeah My my dog baby No Sorry man Kyle Yeah this isn't gonna work out Yeah You get so mad at me with that Yeah you do You do I get worried for Charlotte I don't get mad at you I'm worried for your dog every time Like I have Charlotte They're like oh my God you're Charlotte's mom I'm like no I'm not And then Charlotte looks up at her like well what's happening She's like yeah she's like what am I what is this I give birth to Charlotte What about what about the Children This is different That's a child This is a dog Yeah it's a different species It's not the same species that at least a human is a species that's part of your world and just like I just like not your mom I'm not going to be your mom to the dog Like I'm not her mom by trade I'm a lover not a mother And he was like what's the job of a that's weird That's weird

You got to feed it You gotta take care of it on a couch for six hours I'm calling Children's Services I think Ok here's the parallel You can't leave a dog or a baby in a car without leaving the windows I'm kidding No you can't leave you can't leave either one of them in the car You can't leave either one in the car Yeah you can't do it Can't do it Last one buddy last one you're allergic to them In what way In what way I gotta go I gotta put this down I'm gonna go from real life because that's not a thing from real life First date She tells you that she hasn't dated anyone in a serious relationship for 11 years Oh I thought it was 10 It's I think 11 put puts it past the decade Right So it even extends that it's a good story This is a real person Oh boy Uh it was 11 0 no I didn't You just don't listen What that does is it tells me it it makes me I would say assume that this person has dealt with something that was traumatic and something that was pretty devastating and that you may have to live up to something like to to make that better And I don't I I don't know if it's a red flag It it's it's a red flag but I I don't know if it's one that's a deal breaker No Right Right I took it I took it as a red flag Uh but then I was like uh this is not a deal breaker because I may be the one that breaks the chain Who knows That's what I was saying She went on a date with you She's now single for another 11 years This guy she dates she's like married by like October dress on girl Thanks Full dress on person That's not at all Awesome I hope you guys had a good day like Mr uh Mr uh have a good day on the show Me You guys are awesome Thank you Thank you for coming here Say whatever you want Oh Lord I'm so bad at this time I'm Daniel Hall Uh I like uh my my email stuff is not email What am I doing See basically go to Instagram and you can find it the original Daniel Hall They said that's me at Instagram That's all you need to know You can say it out Uh go to Instagram and find my tag at the original Daniel Hall and it's not all bad Anyway you guys Awesome So basically check out this amazing show come back to Day good Day live and Sway TV and all this wonderful stuff for you guys Thank you for having me and see you guys again soon He's a professional I love it You are back in your day and spread your whoever you miss looks away
