said let you and I give you get straight here You're the good guy and the bad guy I says if I do something wrong you arrest me if you catch me But if you think you're gonna get something from my drunken girlfriend I should I'll spin you around in a courtroom by myself I should And you know we had a really great respect for each other After that day they got a job to do We don't spit at them we don't hit them They come right You could just call us up we'll go turn ourselves in Of course they know we do that but they don't do it because they like the big you know I look at these guys these politicians oh they came with 20 something Jesus Christ They had 28 guys around my freaking apartment building All right Come on and you know give me a break That's what they do All right let them do it Why complain All right worry about it after you get you know try to get yourself out of prison Ok That's the whole ultimate goal Once you go in it's a mindset Ok People ask me how how was it You just change the mindset and that was it I was in prison That was gonna be my life for the period of time I was there your mindset before even before prison and incarceration Uh was that something you think could be taught or is it something you felt you just like is natural to somebody you know mindset and attitude Ok I've been hustling since I was 12 years old What were you doing At 12 Oh no I was I was a newspaper boy I was cutting lawns in the summer shoveling walks in the winter I was making money All right And it's just something that I remember the first time I wrote Thinking Grow Rich It was after the first time I went broke I lost \$12 million from reading that book No not from reading that book I had to take a job and I was sent to school two weeks in Boston with W Clemens Stone a combined Group insurance company And the first book they gave us to read was they can grow rich And when I read that book I said man this old bastard who wrote this book uh he took everything I've been doing in my life and put it in a book So you know all those things work hear that buy think and grow rich But before you do that by this book that's the first thing you gotta do is get off your butt and go to work if you wanna be successful and that's what people don't do that That's why 87% of the people will never make it Is that the number Yeah I tried telling Kyle I tried telling Kyle Um so a lot of the things that I do don't immediately get a return on my investment It's not an immediate thing because I'm a creative And so what I do is I like like yourself like I'll put myself out there and try different things to see what will stick But uh but Kyle is so funny he's he's the business guy where he's like how much are you getting paid I was like not yet Nothing yet But I think I think I think I said how much are you gonna make from this I don't think
