From hot spots and hidden gems to lots of local flavor It's your guide to L A The unscripted Way from Marina Del Rey Hello everyone and welcome to L A unscripted I'm de from the warehouse restaurant in Marina Del Rey which is Spanish for Marina of the King Right now let's give you a royal tour of one of our newest and most favorite places to see And so here's tonight's L A Revealed Fannie's is a restaurant located inside of the Academy Museum Today we're having the first quarterly owned family dinner at Fannie's inspired by the movie The Godfather and serving all our products What we wanted to do was bring Old Hollywood with like a modern twist right So basically not take ourselves too serious but guide people through a culinary and also theatrical journey Can you even envision what your life would have been without the Godfather I I would have a good life but not like this This is insane now because you know I'm the grand ambassador for all the products and um travel the world and the movie is now across five generations It's crazy and I love it So when the museum launched the Godfather exhibit around November of last year We ended up doing a Sunday Supper Godfather series as well And what that entails is a Southern Italian inspired menu four course meal \$85 a person But listen to this I think it's so fantastic It's Vito Corleone bread and olive oil with Jino of oil Of course Luca Rossi sleeps with the fishes Amazing reference Clemens Sunday gravy which is of course a and try to be the best in the city obviously and leave the gun Take the cannoli which is your scene Oh that is so good No Johnny is so good This in the movie Clemenza was teaching Michael how to make sauce just in case we go to war you have to feed 100 people This looks So I've never I don't know if I've ever had this kind of cake No it's a it's a traditional it's the same cake Really OK Oh well that was really good And look at the gold on there Yeah the gold wouldn't be on this in a real Italian wedding They'd rob it And to me this this means so much to me because that was the first thing I ever made in my life was the wedding scene It was the first week of me being an actor I played Carlo getting married to the Don's daughter Well having Johnny Russo here um I think is extremely delightful Being able to have someone who you know was an integral part in the movie playing Carlo Rizzi being able to guide guests on you know an amazing private tour discussing different anecdotes and just experience on set really allows the people to be immersed in the movie So that's why Jimmy Caan nobody knows this had a chip on his shoulder because when I got involved in this he

thought I got him fired then he became Sonny which is the smaller part and they brought him puccino I'm not to do with all this but you know in the beating scene he broke two ribs and chipped my elbow and we choreographed it for a day before and nothing happened that day beat me up What's your fondest memory from the Godfather Filming my relationship with Marlon Brenda we became such friends He tried to get me fired first I said well wait a minute now I don't know protocol on the on the set I've never been in a on the set I said France let's go over there in a minute I dismissed the director Then the room went quiet Everybody was there You could hear a pin drop So they told me not to look at him I put my arm around and I walked him in the back So I get eyes eye to eye with this guy I said let me tell you something Now listen to what I'm gonna say You get me fired I will suck on your heart You will die here today He looked at me He said that was brilliant You could do this part He thought I was acting I mean that how long did you all stay friends We stayed friends until he died The exhibit stays until March 2025 and will be partaking in the Sunday Godfather series every single Sunday up until then So what does it mean to have your olive oil your food your movie all of this together and one place celebrating 50 plus years Well I tell you to me it's overwhelming because you know it deserves it Understand I'm just a street guy to have this privilege Everything means something to me in this movie What was your favorite part about shooting that movie being in it You know one of the great things about Marina Del Rey is the energy you really feel in the air Just staying here is another great way to live local But you can also do this Let's set sail in the Barbie boat full speed ahead L A unscripted is about to set sail at vision electric boat rental I'm doing it We're located in Newport Beach at the Lido Marina Village We started with six boats I believe in 2017 right now 30 boats bigger lagoons I think we have the biggest operation of electric boat rentals in Newport We do actually Well we brought in uh different colors that made us look clearly We're in the pink one Yeah we we looked a bit odd and we said to ourselves you know what This is not old port this is Newport Ok Now you fully realize you're trusting me to drive this boat I I'm not even good at driving a car Is that right But you do have a driver's license correct I mean it was taken away by the judge but I mean I had one at one point It's very easy Our fantastic staff gives amazing rundowns maps Come with the boat They tell you where to go where not to go The experience is easy Fantastic adorable Sometimes as you can tell and uh everybody's having fun This is what we do We sell fun So we've just partnered up with a cater company which is called the Launch

So we're a catering company We specialize specifically in offering maritime provisions for the yachting community here in Newport Beach but most specifically for leader electric boats And so you do like Charcuterie trays Tell me all the things you do Charcuterie fruit platters We have a beautiful organic cru platter We do our Sangria our house made Sangria that we serve in these little cheers to you Yeah ferry paddle boards kayaks sailboats anything manpower or powered by the wind you're gonna duck them meaning go behind them You said deck them I was like that's probably not a good idea So we have a base price of \$150 an hour with a minimum of two hours Got it However weekdays Monday through Thursdays it is half price and on weekends departures at 10 a.m. we call it the early fish special instead of the early bird instead of the early bird is also half price for Now What if people want to bring their kids or pets Kids are always welcome Pets are always welcome Really Yes we are the only dog friendly boat rental in Newport And you can also stop on dining dog in a few restaurants that we have here Who thought this was a good idea I'm not seaworthy I'm not land worthy either The best part is to come here during the weekdays because then you have no danger of hitting anyone else and it's so calm and the water is like glass and it's amazing I love this Want to put your purchasing power to good use in the City of Angels Here's how to think big but shop small So for Beverly Hills Laundry our tagline is Linger for a night in or a night out So we definitely try to create pieces that are versatile for both in and out of the bedroom Hi I'm Jolene Hi I'm Celine And we're the founders of Beverly Hills We started Beverly Hills Lingerie in 2018 when we noticed the gap in the street wear lingerie markets just like a fun way to get people to understand outer wear lingerie So you can style our corsets like the one my sister and I are wearing now over the tops or under a blazer as I have it What we could do is we could add a feather trim be just towards the bottom which I think would be really fun We have women around us who want to feel that sexiness feel the confidence feel empowered lingerie was originally made by a man for a man's pleasure But it's it's definitely changed The narrative has changed and we just want to be a part of that narrative and collection our ethnic background We are proud to be Persian We're Persian Americans Our parents both came from Iran about 40 years ago They created a beautiful life here and a wonderful family for themselves right now wearing lingerie or the idea of lingerie in our home country and our parents' home country of Iran would be banned banned very taboo not allowed So with the current political uprising in Iran my sister and I we're going through so much pain not

knowing who to turn to how to turn to anyone We wrote a blog post on our website about our feelings around the current Iranian situation We watch with tears of sadness and tears of pride that the Iranian women are standing up to the clergy that control their moves and being we look forward to a day where Iranian women aren't stripped of basic human rights no longer live in fear and are not left broken inside Being Persian American women who launched a brand in Los Angeles We definitely felt like even though our voice was small we could still have a voice and to give hopefully the women here Persian American women and the Persian women in Iran a little bit of a voice and for them to know that we support them here in Los Angeles And we feel very very lucky to live the privileged lives that we do here And we wish the same for them in these past 4.5 years We've stayed true to our values our morals um our ethics as sisters and business partners and we've been able to establish such strong relationships with our customers The Beverly Hills lingerie self love is you cannot fill someone else's cup unless your cup is full So the most intimate relationship you'll have with anyone is the one you have with yourself So to be able to have a strong identity and be able to express that in fashion is something so important to us and something so important for us to share with the world We've got a lot more shows to come back after the break For more A unscripted Welcome back to scripted I'm de from the warehouse restaurant in Marina Del Ray Ok Here's a little in the know about this restaurant It first opened its doors in 1969 and it's filled with old wine and whiskey barrels shipping crates fishing net and real number from abandoned shipyards and so cool Right All right Now let's get you in the know about another fun spot Our goal is to bring our cuisine to the level where other cuisines are Reason number 1000 I love this show You always get to try stuff you've never tried before Today we're trying a Pakistani restaurant in Fullerton and then Michelin recognized on top of it all concept It's a halal farm to table Pakistani Indian Afghani cuisine where we make sure that quality of the food and the ingredients that we use comes from farm from farmers and local farms Oh my God Every single dish here has been a 10 out of 10 I've only had three and still where to go What concept means It's a very popular name People especially from a tribe back home Northwest Pakistan That's where this tribe comes from and concept It's a legacy It means like it's a very respected name and look how it keeps all the steam inside here Oh my God Born in Pakistan came here in the year 2000 when I was 17 years old started as a dishwasher and always wanted to eat out I've always wondered like how come our food cannot be presented in a way

where like Italian French cuisine is presented to present Pakistani food to a level where we can be proud of it that our food tastes good but it looks good as well So we'll start with the Panipuri So can we just talk about how cute this cart is You take the puff pastry put a water in there OK Just take one bite and you will have an explosion of spices in your mouth OK Let's have an explosion of spices Wow you're right That's an explosion The way we designed our menu it was uh street food Heavily street food And we got some items from Pakistan We got some you know dishes from Afghanistan some dishes from Bangladesh some dishes from India because we wanted to bring everything in one roof That's why we call ourselves Daisy craft kitchen because the term Daisy means people from South Asia This is the Sloppy Joe your version of the sloppy Joe Sloppy Joe We call it sloppy co it's minced beef It's regular meat and uh cooked with onion tomatoes and spices I would come to Fullerton It's about an hour away just for that That's how good it was This Sloppy Con the Sloppy Con 10 out of 10 I have a smoked Negroni for you And it's a mock right This is not a mock no alcohol as a Muslim We wanted to give an experience of like how the bar works right I mean we all go out but we can't sit at the bar and we all miss that experience that how does it feel to be behind the bar So we created a bar and we were like to come up with like craft mocktails The only difference is we don't use alcohol but we use alcohol substitute So it's the same thing without the buzz That is so good It's so refreshing You know what Honestly like I just said there's not been a miss on this table We've had so many dishes Now I get why you're Michelin recognized Tell me about this So the Holy Festival it's a festival of color where you put color on anybody strangers without any race without any color without anything So it's all about love and acceptance The message of like oh that's so sweet How do you do You just you just grab it and throw it in the air just like this just like this All right Still more to come to go grab a cocktail and don't you dare touch that remote will be right back Welcome back to unscripted I'm Devin from the warehouse restaurant in Marina Del Rey time Now for one of my favorite segments in the show And yes it's definitely because it has my name in it but I'm ok with that All right Check out my latest Dana Da It never fails to amaze me We find the coolest stuff on the show This one so amazing circus school right here in Hollywood Surf School is a recreational circus facility located in the heart of Hollywood where if you've got a fantasy of running away with the circus you can come here and do it seven days a week Give me all your money The thing about it is that in circus traditionally it was people with different skills and abilities

and the beauty of the circus was that you found where you were great and where you excelled and then they amplified that we do that same kind of thing here Oh my God Circ school's founder Aloisia Gabre came from Cirque du Soleil She started training in the circus when she was a little girl in San Francisco with the Pickle Family circus And when she came here she wanted to bring circus to the general public So her whole philosophy and what all of us coaches live by is that this is for anybody with anybody bend this knee and look it's called beauty on the bow because you look you look like a beauty on the bow of a ship Wait what's the word I'm king of the world are you are roast Let's go Circus When taught properly is all core based and about using your body to its most efficient capacity It's your own skill your own talent your own drive your own ambition for our 101 classes which are open to anybody in the public and then we get you on basic skills So for the aerial classes that will be on aerial silks or static trapeze We also do contortion We have kids classes The contortion class is taught by Cirque Du Soleil professional contortionist Our acrobatics classes are taught by professional dancers and acrobats That's my own creation That's called the Dana So we have a great discount code specifically for unscripted viewers If you go to the CF school website at circ school dot com sign up for a class and use the coupon code unscripted You'll get 50% off your first class which is amazing because you could bring a date you could bring a best friend you could bring your mother who wants something more exciting in life You know I think this restaurant might actually be one of the most fun places to work And so because you're surrounded by the stunning views you've got the great food but Jasmine Sims and another great local spot summer bodies are made all year long at former Pilates and Ellie unscripted We're getting our sweat on today at their hidden Hollywood studio Let's go Pilates is based around the former method I take the core essence of classical Pilates and I kind of give it a little spice and twist a lot of abs and glutes and obviously 100% of your core in a more slow and controlled environment that the shakes are coming I feel them too and now you're gonna pike lift your hips up look towards your thighs try to close that that's something that I created Actually during COVID I bought a reformer for personal use and decided to just train myself and I would post it on Instagram and then friends would reach out and wanna come get on the machine I started with one reformer in my mom's back house in her pool house I didn't want to call it like Pilates by Liana because I decided that I wanted the brand to evolve into other things but also not solely rely on Liana For me I was like how can I make this like a

sexy feminine sophisticated brand And I just thought of format it means shape in Spanish because I think for definitely helped put Pilates on the market for the younger generation went to school or had a ton of mutual friends um in common with some celebrities and it kind of just spread through word of mouth I mean Laurie Harvey I remember when she came she came here and she was a girl on a mission and she came six days a week consistently for I would say like two months holy cow I'm surviving guys We're very detail oriented So we kind of teach you the proper form what you're working that mind body connection that is the benefits of being in a smaller class It's a lot more communication length and beautiful and slowly bent and press That's it I opened this studio almost two years ago This was my first brick and mortar We launched also our online platform At the same time as we opened the studio online is great because it's accessible to everybody all around the world And we do both mat and reformer Each video is more challenging than the next And we incorporate a lot of fun accessories like ankle weights and weight stability ball has it little Let's go for 10 beautiful 933376 That's it You got it five more seconds 432 And every morning I wake up and I'm I'm shocked at how far we've come It's definitely taken a lot of hard work A lot of learning experiences I'm not like a big studio I'm here to really kind of sell a lifestyle and a brand that embodies kind of 360 degrees of wellness versus just Pilates And that is all the time we have for tonight Thank you so much to the warehouse restaurant for our beautiful surroundings Thank you guys We'll see you next time Good night
