From hotspots to hidden gems This is your guide to all things local The L A unscripted way from carnival dinner show From fire eaters to sword swallows Oh my God Oh my God Five star food and flaming cocktails Ladies and gentlemen step right up This is your ticket to be transported back in time to a 1920 steam circus What's that Come see Hi everyone I'm de I'm your ring leader and be prepared to be amazed as we go off script and reveal why carnival L A is the hottest ticket in town is she ok So check on her Yeah Welcome to Car and Evil Welcome to the home of the freaks the geeks the strange the odd and the unusual tonight on this very stage you're gonna see bar None Every sight sound and miracle that that name stands for We have a to titillate sensations to tantalize and they're all inside here Welcome L A unscripted to carnival Hollywood Carnival is a nightly dining theatrical experience where we take you back to the early 1900 steam circus with food and drink and incredible entertainment It is a 90 minute full blown experience Of nonstop energy and fun This is the what can you expect You can expect Cirque Du Soleil acts We actually have some performers that come directly to us from Cirque Du Soleil high flying aerialists comedy jugglers So this is our La Fe Verte which is kind of like a riff on a martini OK And the cool thing about this one is you get to have a little bit of fire with it Ok I'm just saying if I have enough of these cocktails I'm gonna get a little freaky with it Carnival is a home to whatever you need it to be whether you're celebrating a birthday an anniversary a divorce you do you or just a crazy night out One of the amazing things about this show is that every night it's different no two shows will ever be the same is \$50 and that gets you four tapa style plates and we take our classic carnival food and turn it on its head corn dogs corn dogs Those are wagyu beef mini corn dogs Absolutely Those right There are duck tacos But you gotta try you gotta try this though You have to try our chicken lollipop It's delicious Actually it's really good Here in in Hollywood there is nothing quite like what we do You can find entertainment menu You can go up the street to the pantages or down the street to the El Capitan but there's nothing that ties that immersive experience of food and drink and entertainment into one incredible package for the evening And you know there are multiple seats under the carnival big top and be prepared to get celebrity treatment wherever you said I thought it was just me But all clowns are welcome Ok I'm dead serious I'm so excited Oh my God Oh my God this is it the cloud I heard about you I heard about you

Ok No more clowning around Now let's check in with our Jasmine Simpkins to find out where else uns are Sure I think people who as they get older they want to find an environment where they can both get pierced with a needle and one that feels fun and accessible to them Hi I'm Anna Harmon I'm the CEO and co founder of Studs studs is an ear piercing and earrings destination where you can get healthy and safe needle piercings for your ears and then buy affordably priced and on trend jewelry So a few years ago I went to go get a second piercing and I ended up going to a tattoo parlor and while the piercing experience was great I was very personally out of place there and I didn't love the jewelry and I felt like there was really an opportunity to combine healthy and safe needle piercings with a place that you could shop for fun jewelry Lisa actually came up with the name she's my co founder in our CMO we focused on a few different iterations of names but really honestly Studs rang the truest for us And so we went with it We launched Studs November 2019 in Nolita in downtown New York And then we also launched studs dot com at that time And then we launched uh Hudson Yards February 2020 And then recently we just launched Austin on South Congress We launched Boston in the seaport and Melrose Place designing these stores is my favorite thing to do and we use a lot of neon We also play on the shape of the ear So this is the ear bar and it is actually in the shape of an ear and there's a lot of curvature and sort of organic ear shapes in the space We are ears only So we are all about ears here So we only do ear piercings and we only sell earrings All right L A You it's time for a whole new me Let's go I love it Seriously I'm so excited It looks amazing Thank you Let's do more What should I do Well let's escape you That is all about using your ear for self expression and using your escape to say something about who you are We've got the large crescent who our new L A said in the second hole and our hinge cuff where you can sort of fake a third conch piercing which I love And it looks amazing with your new pave lightning bolt Helix piercing I really do feel like a whole new me Seriously This is like amazing guys Do you see this Oh my gosh Life changer So where is your off script Happy place Make sure to DM us and let us know here at carnival they say if you can imagine it you can experience it no limits And now another local adventure to see So here we are in the height of the Sunset Strip and Sunset Boulevard is a hidden treasure down a very European magical pathway And then finally you come to this this beautiful little English cottage So we're here to reveal mystery peer books Every book in this shop is a true first state of the first edition It's all highly sought after collectible

investment literature First editions escalate in value are more important than art They go up constantly Now here we have an invaluable set Tolkien's Lord of the Rings in collecting books The dust jacket is the most important part of the book These are immaculate We have a tremendous amount of celebrity clients um whose libraries we've built and who collect from us Everyone actually comes in here Flea's been coming to us for over 20 years Guillermo Del Toro a long time Johnny of course Colin Farrell Jimmy Page Jimmy's been coming a long time It's great to find when people come in here whether they're the famous ones are just men or women off the street and they see a book and you see the joy in their eyes when they see something that they've oh I love this book They are an invaluable part of life And so people who treasure books are special to Louis And I one of the most iconic books here is Gone With The Wind has a card inside signed by Clark Gable and Vivien Leigh \$15,000 And then there's 12 years a slave which is written in 1853 1 copy sold to the producers of the movie and they donated it to the Smithsonian And this is the other 1 \$5000 The Casino Royale the first of the James Bond books It's an immaculate copy But because of that staining we have reduced the price We have this for \$25,000 I mean instead of being in a way it's someone that would be that you know when it does go we appreciate it It's very gratifying to see books go to people who do as Louis said really appreciate it And you know that they're gonna value the book they're gonna appreciate it Not just because of what they've spent but of course of what that book represents you know they say happiness is like a carnival ride It's never as easy as it looks That's why we're here And this lau carnival from Carnival L A on Hollywood Boulevard is just starting to tilt the world more local fun to be had in minutes from side shows to side dishes Carnival on Hollywood Boulevard puts the Mary and Merry making Welcome back to L A scripted Everyone I did de and carnivals Conjure up all the fun f words Not that one I'm talking family food and free Yes And check out what happened when we hang out in this immersive dinner experience So how about we just like cross your legs to do cute little pin up style I'm going to give you a little spin OK Once I spin you just try your back look beautiful and sexy as you are maybe maybe you'll feel good enough to maybe that one hand Maybe you lean back just do a little body Your flip Oh my God She like like what about this You ready for a little OK here we go OK All right Maybe one hand releases Yes Oh my God How about both hands on But lean back OK Yes And look at the camera hands up nice and high on an even shoulder with a heart You're going to let one hand go and you're going to

reach it back Ok Well that could be one of it at that That's not what I mean but OK she's going back to man on the moon Well yeah she's getting creative I like it after that Just call me a car while I'm practicing my new circus skills Let's see what our Olivia Day were to is up to Oaxaca is known as the Mexican foodie paradise And now Cafe Santo brought some of that paradise to Montebello It is a contemporary Oaxacan coffee shop We have like my roots where I'm coming from beans from Oaxaca chocolate from Oaxaca We have a small food menu My chef he is from Oaxaca too So we try to bring a little bit of Oaxaca to L A That's that's cafe Santo cafe Santo starts with a with a dream with a goal like I'm from Oaxaca South Mexico and I moved to L A It's gonna be like 12 years And uh well Oaxaca is such a small town and very rich So I grew up like learning and you know like um appreciating like different like vibes like a music Mezcal all those things art So um I always wanted to open a space to express myself I started working in different places as a dishwasher you know like um using an espresso machine And uh I don't know I just felt a connection with coffee for me Coffee Um It's been like really really beautiful because it has made me improve and to grow in different ways And I wanna open a business and I I wanna express myself through coffee and let's talk about Oaxacan coffee What is what is different about Oaxacan coffee Well the thing about Oaxacan beans and Oaxacan coffee is just it's just the feeling you know like obviously there's a lot of Oaxacans in in LA a lot of like Latino community in in L A So just like having having beans from you know like their hometown from Latino America it makes you feel like a special like a different vibe you know like I don't know like there's something special about that And also I mean Latin American coffees they tend to be like chocolate I mean in Mexico Oaxaca we love the cinnamon chocolate beans So the Oaxacan Oaxacan beans they have like those notes like chocolate nutty flavors So it's something that we love in Latin America and Oaxaca for some of the copies that we have Uh sometimes with the retail bags we try to add like uh an extra dollar that we donate from each each bag that we sell And when it comes to specialty coffee you're always trying to pay a little bit more so that you know it can be sustainable to people in Oregon All right Marlon you're gonna show me how to make your most popular drink right Sounds good Yeah it's called the Oaxaca Moca right here Look how pretty that is and you can see the little chunks of the chocolate Yeah people love that Yeah The little chunks of the ants Oh my God And at the end in cafe Santo we love what we do and we try to express ourselves through coffees What is the fastest ride at a carnival

Nope Not a roller coaster The carousel Why Because it has more horse power Don't worry dad jokes are not on the menu here Clearly I needed a minute All right A and from carnival L A will be right back in the carnival of life We all need to schedule some fun That's what unscripted means to us And here at the carnival dinner show going off script means surprises like this I told you Hi Hi Scarlet how are you Oh my God you are So do you have bones Are you just not connected quite right Yeah there's no ligaments There's no Yeah so I have a surprise for you Ok I heard you were a huge fan of tennis I am actually these should look to do what are these are not so bad either Right in front left hand goes through ok Grab onto the handle Ok And then you're going to twist it up and put your face in Ok Ok And this is the part where it gets weird Ok Because I'm going to dislocate my shoulder Oh God Ok Pull it down So I'm just gonna oh there we go And then I go Who are you guys See you look a little stuck another way to get out of your comfort zone Say yes to a dare Just like I did Hey Dana this is Suzie from tooth candy and I double dog dare you to get your bite blinged with a tooth gem We've done the Kardashians You know we did Kendall we did a little gold cross on her Also done Ariana Grande We did a disco ball on her You know people are all about the cosmetic world What can I do to stand out And I think two gems are the perfect way to do that The first time I saw too Jam was in Europe it blew my mind I had to start doing to gems out here in order for me to get one with the help of an orthodontist is how to candy was born Welcome to So we are here in the city of South Gate which is 10 minutes away from downtown L A and this is where we were I was actually born and raised here We had to candy for nine years now Ok Dana So these are your options We carry so of crystals or we can do some gold charge Ok Some real di Wow So we ready Yeah the two G is applied on your tooth The way dentist apply Race is on to your t so it's a dental bond that can be easily removed at any time with a quick trip to the dentist to ensure no damage to your too If everybody's wearing a mask why would they want to do this right now Well basically it's kind of like lingerie you know it's there and not everybody has to see it But it still kind of makes you feel special All right Dino we're all done We're done We're done Let's check it out Oh my God Wow It's DD for day or day The best way to get a hold of us and get into our studio is to go online and book an appointment Have a day to day You want me to try Let me know because truth I say yes a lot And now yes another neighborhood Everybody from Dean Martin to Kendrick Lamar to Nancy Sinatra to Michael Jackson to panic at the disco Everybody has recorded at

United Recording I am Victor Harak I am revealing where music's biggest legends have recorded their greatest hits OK Here we are at our wall of fame Well here's Mick Fleetwood Uh Here's five members of the doors Queens of the Stone Age Google dolls The studio opened up in 1958 by studio pioneer Bill Putnam and was financed by two amazing icons Bing Crosby and Frank Sinatra This is what we call the Frank Sinatra room So Frank Sinatra did a lot of hits when he left Capitol Records Uh Here in the early sixties including it was a very good year and strangers of the night was done in here The building actually dates back to 1918 It was actually one of the beginnings of the sound stages of Columbia Pictures It wasn't until 1958 when it got changed to a recording studio and think about all the crooners all the jazz masters That's how it all began This is a Steinway D it was built in 1966 and it came from Motown to think that uh Marvin Gaye played this piano It's one of the most coveted pianos in the city I started here 33 years ago On my very first day it was Barbara Streisand Barry White the red hot chili peppers Lionel Richie and I forgot the other one But it was like that was just one day That's what it is like Even today This is what we have here is a focus right 72 input console only 10 in the world were made and only four exist today A lot of amazing records were done here including Kendrick's very last record that he just came out with was done here in this room This room is also notorious for Lionel Richie's all night long was done here We think about the 64 years of existence Here's Nancy Sinatra who actually came and paid us a visit one day who did her iconic record These boots are made for walking here in studio B we are here in studio B which was we known as the rock and roll room bands like Radiohead tool panic at the disco It's great for rock and roll because you can really push limits with this room So you have here the umbrella which you can isolate the instrument what's under it For example Green Day they call this room their sound because this is the drum room that you want to get So when you hear American idiot that's this room you know recording is located at the heart of Hollywood right at the entrance of the Sunset Gower Studios The vinyl district hits all the way to gower So which where we're at right now and what's so important because we we all celebrate music and being that we are music creators here It's very important that we are in this area because of the resurgence of vinyl We actually have an extensive archive department where people can preserve their old recordings We digitize and preserve them and make them into vinyl records We all love music and us here at United we've been the soundtrack for people's lives for the past 64 years and we'll continue to do so today Oh

my God you guys we had the best time today We have to thank everybody here at Carnival L A Oh my gosh You guys thank you so much I am joining the circus as soon as I get out of the strait jacket and someone here said they're going to help me get out So can you help me get out this jacket Hey can you help me get out of the jacket Ok Ok Ok
