From hot spots and hidden gems to lots of local flavor It's your guide to L A the unscripted way And tonight we're taking you to we're about to prove that gun is so much more than where the airport is Hello everyone and welcome to L A unscripted I'm de and we are taking over the neighborhood of a thriving beach side community with a real town charm home to the Chargers the Lakers the Kings the Los Angeles Times the Los Angeles Air Force Base dozens of fortune 500 companies And now this we're revealing the ultra cool top golf We're growing the game everywhere We make it non intimidating It's fun There's many different ways that somebody can come work on their game as a beginners expert It doesn't matter We're for everybody at top golf sedo Yes Our facility is 65,000 square feet with 26 acres over at the golf course and it's 102 climate controlled hitting base that you can fit up to eight guests per day and six can play We have three different bars one on each level This is so nice So if you want to watch some tennis and you want to watch it on this TV That's exactly right You see kids here you see families you see business professionals and you see pros occasionally practicing here as well So it's a great combo boom See a difference That was so much better Top golf it's target oriented practice and that's what top and top golf means And we have different targets all the way from 25 yards up to 220 yards in the trench and top golf scores in all targets And another cool technology that we have is Top tracer We have these high tech cameras that are on the venue that break down the speed trajectory and angle of your golf ball So we have these neat courses like ST Andrews and these virtual golf of course And we have something called angry birds which is cool Tell me how it all started Yeah I'd love to say this story because we evolved off an idea in a golf ball It was two brothers They were twins in the United Kingdom a little over 20 years ago were coming up with a fun way to track their golf ball and they came up with that RF ID microchip in the golf ball And now we've grown to over 70 locations around the world Oh yeah I have to say not only is it top tier Gulf this is top tier food wings and doughnut holes and fried chicken sandwiches and pretzel bites Ok I could not be more excited about this one though So we have Bavarian cream chocolate and raspberry and you can fill that right in the doughnut And for every order that we do sell we donate a dollar to make a wish foundation very important with our charity All right we better is there on my face in these cocktails in the light up glasses are amazing What are these We have

our turf monster over here in our golf bag and we have a pineapple punch Congratulations on awesome food here Oh my God I love this place And coming up I'm going to put my new found golf skills to the test by hitting the balls with the mayor of gun Do you don't want to miss that Right There are so many great places to check out in this community especially when it comes to the art scene They were to took a friend to live local at the Museum of Art and uncovered some major Hollywood Magic We are touring a new experience here as Mola and I brought my new friend Matthew to join us Mom always said life was like a box of chocolates You never know what you're gonna get As Moa is the El Seo Museum of Art We have been open since 2013 We're about to celebrate our 10th anniversary Hi My name is Paloma Nicholas and I am the education specialist at ES Moa essentially we have different kinds of programming geared towards different age groups and different interests This is the Jurassic Zone right now We have our time experience It's a retrospective of sorts for the production designer Rick Carter He is truly the visionary behind blockbuster films from the eighties nineties and two thousands like Star Wars Avatar back to the future of Forrest Gump Everything that is represented in that space He was a production designer for it's all based on this idea of the movies right And so they all kind of merged together to become this one big story And here we have Forrest Gump Everything that you're seeing on the walls uh was mostly created by eight L A based mostly self described graffiti artists When he came in he sat down with all of us and he had this idea to actually like recreate what it would be like if we were all working on the set together And we all were coming up with these ideas and collag together and putting all these things together Now we're all in that in his head This map was done by one of the artists Meraji Khalil Basically Rick wanted her to create a map of sorts to allow people to navigate through the space And there's another one from passed away Wilson again there fedex Truck And then of course in the middle here we have back to the future And above that you see a scene from war horse Everything means that something its neighbor My son I ended up bringing him in and he got to do the child element Oh my your son did this a little hidden Oscar right there There's an avatar in a corner over there Lots of avatar avatar in a corner over there And this is actually one of my favorite collages I think this collage really does represent him Well I really want to talk about this one because I heard from a little birdie that this is yours This is the boy from A I and he's holding his little teddy bear It was hard for me to figure out how I was gonna do this in a way that people could connect with it

Was this the actual Forrest Gump Yeah there was a box of chocolates here OK We all we've learned anything from COVID It's that we need art more than ever Art is such a wonderful way of practicing mindfulness and checking in with yourself not just experiencing artwork and coming to museums to you know be inspired but also just the practice of it yourself at home And Matthew and Olivia worked up a real thirst skating so much Hollywood movie knowledge and clearly I did just watching So they headed over to our six distillery home of L A very first bourbon and an actual the easy tasting room Let's get in the know what in the Willy Wonka Chocolate Factory Is this behind me This is Jackie She's our hybrid still She has a name She does We are a veteran and family owned distillery based in L A County We're actually L A's first legally distilled bourbon R six is a a tribute paying homage to my family for my great grandfather and his five brothers the six Rubens brothers that built the Rubens Roto Theater back in Chicago in 1926 Fast forward Four generations The distillery was my brainchild that uh came to fruition And you have like an actual production line Yeah So like Lucy and Ethel style you are making like that's so cool I like we make alcohol and then we actually heat it up evaporate it and that's the process of distilling distillations Whiskeys are overarching umbrella but we've got bourbon under that We've got a Rye We have a blue corn bourbon and a single malt and a caramel caramel flavored whiskey Wow they all sound really good But I live in West Hollywood I don't do carbs So the rye is not gonna work for me Our six bourbon and the R six Vodka are my go tos And if I want something really rich it's going to be the R six single malt to our six blue corn bourbon Got it I've been looking for something really rich in this town for a long time and I report I am still single still single sir But if anybody's watching we just won awards both a gold and a silver on the bourbon and a triple gold on the vodka and a few other accolades that just came in the speakeasy thing I think also you know talking about romanticism with spirits making and the whole whiskey industry It just has this kind of like esoteric vibe and feel of I wanna go to a place that I can't be or I'm not supposed to be So this is the speakeasy huh This is it sir Olivia Distill my heart What are you doing here Um Oh what's the password What's the password I forgot it L A L A unscripted I know I liked it here L A unscripted OK This is the vodka the R six Vodka Oh that smells good I'll see you tomorrow That is delicious I love it And I'm not really a vodka drinker So but it's good Yeah so good All right on to the next We have our rye that goes down easy I'm gonna keep this one for sure I have a feeling everything goes down easy here last but certainly not least This is

the R six Bourbon Whiskey This is the main event Folks bottoms up girl Shoot it That one's my favorite Cheers to Elsa Gunda Elsa Gun Whatever your vision is whether it's a theater company or whether it's an internet creation or making scarves and beanies or making booze Like take that vision and act on it You can make it a reality It's never out of reach Matthew Matthew Matt Matthew what do you do Speak less Speak easy What do you do if you can't beat them Join them All right let's go My trunk is open up Maybe we shouldn't leave those two alone in a speak easy Although I'm pretty much alone here at this bar just saying All right will be right back with a little antique car ride through town Welcome back to scripted neighborhood takeover of Gun from top off Did you know a hip hop group a tribe called Quest wrote a song called I Left My Wallet And it's true And maybe we could even get the call to get even more deep And those old town music hall These ws are so good You ready for this Are you ready to travel in time Welcome to Old Town Music Hall Wow this place is incredible It was built in 1921 originally opened as a silent movie theater What you're looking at there is a mighty Ritzer theater pipe organ It's a pipe organ that was built in 1925 to accompany silent movies and also just put on a show So talk about the experience from this perspective The well you're about to have the experience from this perspective the lights go down the curtains open and you see the entire mighty world It's your theater pipe organ percussion system It's got 2500 pipes It's fully acoustic xylophones glockenspiels drums Cymbals The organist sits at the console and can control all of that with just two hands and 2 ft It looks awfully intimidating It is very intimidating Yes I've got a little electronic organ at home and that one's like driving a sports car This thing's like trying to fly a 7 47 Like but you want to learn how to play the siren Sure it's easy This button right there I think that's a siren Oh that's really your first organ lesson And let's see try pushing that button there We'll see what happens Yeah this is really an El Segundo gem It is the the theater is a nonprofit So everyone here is a volunteer Very few people know about it But to those who do come here every weekend buy their popcorn sit down and enjoy the music and the movie coming up the mayor yet the mayor of Gun and I are playing golf and chatting about why this neighborhood is called the second I mean second to none That's coming up Welcome back to L A scripted neighborhood takeover of Gun from top golf And here's a little secret about this place They also do custom club fittings We do club fitting here for Calloway Epic clubs and we do have directors instruction that can fit you versus me because everybody's gonna be different size clubs for their to

tailor to their game Now that I've got golf clubs like a pro I'm about to tee off with the mayor and just a bit But if golf is your idea of fun how about driving around in a 1928 or 1971 A X JJ the streets of the Zimmerman Automotive Museum for real trends with benefits I just love all the details Like you don't get this kind of de detail quality in new cars We're at the Zimmerman Automobile Driving Museum where there's nothing but classic cars for a classic gal We're going for a ride Let's go My name is Marisol Herrera I'm the executive director at the Zimmerman Automobile Driving Museum We're a nonprofit organization that focuses on American vehicles Um We focus on the history and and basically restoration of vehicles We have cars from 18 86 up to 2006 and they're all considered vintage at this point or classic if they're from the early two thousands and we have about 100 and 30 in our collection mostly American but we do have a couple of British cars as well They just don't make interiors like this anymore So this place is open to all ages We have things uh activities for for every age here So behind you is a 1982 DeLorean That one is very popular back to the future Everybody knows that car My favorite car is a 1955 Nash Rambler So we'll rotate them and every time you come you can see a new car Let's go I worked at uh museums from when I graduated high school and on I was at the Natural History Museum the La Brea Tar Pit California Science Center When I found the place I just immediately fell in love And I said you know II I wanna work here Yeah this space in here it's about 15,000 square feet It's utilized for a lot of different things Not only just a museum we have uh parties almost every weekend I also had my reception here and I drove in in that 1940 Darren Packard Darren So I have uh this place has a special place in my heart I'm Richard Croall I'm a board member here at the Automobile Driving Museum That's a 1931 model A Ford This one has every option that the factory offered at the time You guys do a really good job of just keeping them in pristine condition They're so pretty This car is surprisingly easy to drive for an old car 49 49 Crosley and it's a station wagon It was one of the earliest mini cars that America built This is the air conditioning air conditioning Oh my gosh Ok Maybe we wouldn't last an hour in this thing So as you walk around to this side we have some sports cars here British sports cars and uh this is a 1940 Darren Packard That's probably the most interesting and perhaps valuable car in the collection You can come by and get a ride on one of these cars and we do them every Sunday weather permitting And we take three cars out of our collection every weekend and give rides The rides last about 5 to 10 minutes And it's a nice short ride

around El Segundo So you get to see all of the landmarks as well Makes it a simple thing It has a small town feel I feel like everybody knows each other here There's also a lot of cool locations to go hang out and there's the beach as well So it's all in one It's a really great place to live Ok It's not every day We get to do a neighborhood takeover and meet the mayor But today we do we like to say we're the most important five square miles economically in all of southern California More phds per square mile more businesses per square mile more commercial office space per square mile We have more fortune 500 companies in El Segundo than any other city in California Outside San Francisco Raytheon is here Boeing Northrop Grumman AT&T Beyond Meets was born here is based here in El Segu and the list goes on But there are many I've lived here 25 years in El Sego No I love this town I was a single dad when I moved here I was looking for a beach town because I love to surf The place I ended up moving into is a half a mile from the ocean So I could ride my bike to the beach The city of El Segundo is right smack dab on the ocean just north of Manhattan beach and south of LAX So it's perfect for people traveling as far west as you can go And it's kind of center of the South Bay And what is El Segundo mean Means a second And so Chevron oil operates a refinery here in town in 1911 Standard oil built that refinery So they actually built this town they had one refinery in northern California which is I guess El Premi they built this one is the second refinery in the state of California Ok Normally people dare me to do things However today I'm turning things around and I am daring the mayor of gun to t off with me at top Golf You ready I'm ready Let's go Keep your arm straight all the way through Arm straight all the way through Ok And your head steady head steady down on the ball Mouth shut That's hard for me The mouth shut hard for me There you go Ok I was kind of crappy but ok that'll work Let's go No you go you can do it you can do it and you definitely don't want to stand behind me Ok Ok You don't miss just don't miss Ok No one's watching Ok That was pretty good Too much You shark You like you're not good Not to shocking me I'm gonna be ready for the tour by next year By the end of today I'm gonna be ready for the L PGA God See we got it No it's over here It's over here It's about to go Just just missed the trap Ok If I meet you can I be mayor for the day Of course Really You can get a key to the city whatever you want a key Yeah Get your key to the city of El Segundo Oh my God I love that How do we figure out who what Well we're giving you a handicap No I already had a handicap It's called being blonde but I'll take that in Congratulations You're gonna be mayor of El Sego for the day Who do I get

a key We do get it I get a you get a key I love this Ok Mr Mayor don't think I won't come back from my key to the city We had so much fun here at top Golf Thank you guys so much And where will we go off Script next Good night everyone We'll see you next time
