From hot spots and hidden gems to lots of local flavor It's your guide to L A the unscripted way And tonight we're taking you to the beach and more everyone I'm David Devin welcome to L A unscripted It's getting to be that time of year here in So Cal where people start heading to the beach In fact we've got the perfect spot for you to pull up for Mother's Day Memorial Day or just any old day Olivia De Bertoli checks into Laguna It's getting to be that time of year again right here in socal warm weather and beach trips So if you're looking for an amazing getaway right here in your own backyard La Casa Del Camino Hotel It is the ultimate hot spot Let's go inside It's the hidden gem of Laguna Beach It's super historic It's from the 19 twenties The place has so much character the energy when you walk in it has a very homey and welcoming feeling like the rooms are super cute They're really cozy they're really intimate and I think it's just a staple of Laguna Beach So La Casa Del Camino basically translated to the house along the road It's a place another place you can call home your secondary home your safe haven Like I want to call it or also used to like a little piece of heaven We're only one of two rooftops in the area The views that you can get from here whether you're sitting at the bar or you're sitting over here It's kind of what also draws from there You can hear the waves from here It's a really soothing calming feeling So we only have 36 rooms Uh We also have a private house called called La Casita Perfect for families There's uh three bedrooms in there You have a full deck private little g uh driveway there And then on the hotel side we have the Spanish rooms which are flagships and then we also have surf rooms So there's probably a room for everybody if we're going restaurant downstairs the same it's all Spanish style more like pay It's all geared towards more of like a spade type feeling when you're coming in from downstairs Commodore in Spanish means the dining room table And uh here at Commodore our our plates are small They're shareable It's family friendly It's um it's Tapa style food and uh we're just trying to bring a Spanish a beautiful Spanish vibe with the Casa Del Camino to Laguna Beach These are some of your like favorite items Some of the most popular items Absolutely Absolutely All right So walk me through them OK So we'll start you over here with the with the pan cone toma This looks phenomenal This is like this is a beautiful dish It's toasted sourdough bread It's it's uh tomatoes that we grind down a little bit of Manchego cheese and Parmesan finished with herb oil This is like what a crab This is a crab cake with an old bay aioli So these

are lightly lightly sauteed just so you get the crisp on the outside This is much crunchier than your typical crab cake which is awesome This is our crudo greatest fish I think I've ever tried charred octopus It is phenomenal I've got a little bit of Spanish chorizo This is my favorite I think I said that about everything but I won't tell So it's um it's uh prawns it's garlic it's white wine it's sherry and it's and it's butter If I could survive on two things it would be garlic and butter Well done Well done Thank you chef You're welcome Thank you Appreciate it Appreciate it It's a place where you can just come relax and literally forget about whatever was going on back there I hope they take back like a sense of calm calmness just to kind of help them like ease the soul a little bit You're just kind of vibing you're taking in the energy taking in nature and remember that you have a home here as well So it was like that way you know you have a place to come back to whenever you need to escape And Jasmine Simpkins is taking us on an adventure right now deep into history meet the Kinsey family and their incredibly important art collection as they share it with us In 2013 we had over 12 million people see the Kinsey Collection at Epcot So we have chosen to try to do things in a little different way because we believe that the museum audience is changing The Kinsey African American art and history collection is a traveling museum exhibition founded over 50 years ago as a private collection started by my mother and father uh but has taken shape as a public traveling exhibition over the last 15 years It was important for Sofi Stadium in Hollywood Park to partner with the Kinsey family because of the roots that they have in Inglewood The Kinsey are are you're essentially talking about black royalty here in Los Angeles It's hard to put into words how amazing it feels to bring an exhibition first of its kind to sofa stadium in this incredible entertainment venue We're more than just football We are entertainment we are culture When you come through entry seven you start getting the feeling of what you're in for once you reach level two what we've done here is present uh an exhibition that chronicles the past present and informs the future through the lens of historical reference points As well as two and three dimensional fine art This is a sculpture by a black woman named May Howard Jackson This is 18 99 She attended the Philadelphia School art Nobody knows about her and she's not the only one Let's just pause for a second because this is your parents' personal collection My parents were always collecting art I couldn't believe that someone could own it You know what I mean Could own these things but it was part of a quest to preserve and protect this history Uh I used to be a park ranger at Grand Canyon So we

started conducting pine cones dried grasses We didn't have any money So we collected the things that were accessible but it was well in the seventies when we started actually collecting Uh uh Ernie Barnes was our first uh painter We started collecting He is the artist behind that painting on good times Am I Right Yes good times And the sugar shack He just had Marvin Gay's album just done some extraordinary thing and he was a football player My favorite piece is artist Lane Portrait of Shirley and I on our 35th anniversary I mean it just knocked my socks off It's kind of like a full circle moment Really Because we moved to California in 1967 from Florida bought our first house in 1970 right in Inglewood about a mile from here Actually we're just proud uh because none of this was something that we woke up and said we wanted to do Uh and and the response of people coming to so far stadium to see This has just been remarkable This exhibition is for everyone It is meant to inspire and motivate and really spark something that hopefully you know visitors will will want to go further and and explore more I really hope you all get to see that exhibit Now coming to a television near you former playboy bunny Holly Madison's book down the rabbit hole Yep it's being developed right now But in the meantime she's taking over Tik Tok You want to become a cult leader I started making Tik Toks kind of what a lot of people did during quarantine when I was locked in my house about a year and a half ago My most viral video was that silhouette challenge that everybody was doing about a year ago Put your head on my it's so refreshing just to be able to um express myself honestly and you know connect with other people who share similar interests and stuff like that I love that platform I love seeing people be so enthusiastic about so many things on that platform It's super fun If you're brand new to the platform just spend some time on the for you page and see what what do you love seeing and what makes you happy and what makes you light up People do such a great job Just sharing things in such a succinct way That's so fun to watch Yes you can make money through the Creator Fund and sometimes like sponsorship deals will approach me and stuff and I've connected with a lot of different things on there It's so much fun So it's made me like people more like that's the best thing I think Coming up flamingo dancing and high flying trapeze acts Yep I did it believe it or not That's coming up Here we go I am so excited for the first time ever The Hollywood Bowl and Toyota are teaming up all with a common goal of going green I'm gonna take this baby for a spin I think it's a perfect partnership but Hollywood is extremely going green It's a great green company and of course Toyota is as well So I think Hollywood Ball Toyota

together That's a perfect harmony match right there We're really excited to be partnering with Toyota These are two companies organizations that believe in the future that believe in going green We believe in environmental sustainability We're always trying to find ways in which we can continue to be even more eco friendly reduce our carbon emissions year after year Make this place more sustainable Oh yeah Look at the bird's eye and then you can even zoom in if you wanted to stands out most uniquely about the D for it's our first ever fully electric vehicle for Toyota Battery electric vehicle that's available in all 50 states Also the name is kind of unique It stands for beyond zero because Toyota truly wants to go beyond zero Not just with the way the emissions comes out of the vehicle of course it's zero emissions but how we produce it how we make it the factors that it comes from we want to be almost zero emissions by the year 2050 We're celebrating our 1/100 season this year You know we want to make sure that we are doing our part to make sure that the bowl is environmentally friendly and so that we can really continue to make this place go on for the next 100 years This is why it's so exciting to be partnering with Toyota the launch of the new vehicle things like that not only align with what we believe in but it inspires us to look beyond what we're currently doing and see what we can do even more This is living right here I tell you I like it This is the way to do it This will be our first vehicle that has Toyota save 3.0 So it takes our Toyota save 2.5 and adds even better features to it It's our first vehicle Like I said that's fully electric When you plug it in it gets you about 250 miles of all electric driving and then just stick it in It's right there Wow that's it Just like that you're ready to go It's a lot easier than getting gas 100% It's amazing when you get inside of it got a great glorious looking interior and it's really spacious too because of course when you have an EV vehicle you have basically just batteries underneath the vehicle So you'll see how the back passengers have tons of leg room The front passengers have amazing amount of leg room The materials are really nice on the inside It's a very spacious feel to it to make it even more spacious So of course you have this nice panoramic moon roof right here I like that It goes all the way to the back which is really nice It's going to continue to have that Toyota reliability As a matter of fact it starts about 250 miles worth of range 10 years from now Toyota has said it's going to hold 90% of its original range So think of a Corolla how the engine lasts forever with this BZ four X with a battery technology It's going to last forever as well So I like this actually I think he's gonna buy one everybody I think I might You want me to back there Er though Yes I think I sold two I

don't sell the cars but I'd get one too So and you didn't even do anything No I just kept my mouth shut You just drove it and you experienced it you get tons of incentives you get government incentives you get California incentives And as a matter of fact Toyota just announced a few weeks ago that we're partnering with EV Go So for your first year of ownership you will get unlimited free charging to their access to their charging stations Toyota we kind of lead the way we started the hybrid industry I don't think anybody does it better than us and I think we'll do the same thing with the EV market as well This is a place where you come early and you have a picnic you meet with friends and family you have a drink you have a dinner to have this Toyota Lounge for our patrons to be able to come and enjoy the bowl and this really cool setup It's an enhancement of the space It's a beautiful place for you to come out here Any time you want to see a concert here at the Hollywood Bowl you do not have to even be a Toyota owner We welcome everybody So come on out have a seat in our lounge grab a drink We're all part of this community The bowl is all about community as a part of this community We need to do our part to make sure that this place is not just its part but setting an example Hi everyone Welcome back to L A unscripted and if you're looking for something fun to do this summer then How about dance lessons better yet How about flamenco dance lessons Doug Cok has the des on how not to have two left feet Never thought I'd see Doug Cok Flamenco dancing My name is Doctor Coco Cabrel I'm known as the flamenco dancing MD around and around Can you go all the way Yeah I really help people to choose themselves so that they can find their inner joy Bring this leg together and now do the other leg using MD designed flamenco inspired movement and exercise I've been an anatomy and physiology professor for 30 years and I've been a flamenco dance professor for almost 20 for all this time I've been trying to figure out you know how can I make this power of flamenco accessible This is a flamenco case within their first month I've had people lose 6 £9 easy easy with this cape now kind of twist away from your extended leg So that yeah And now whoosh Yeah So that's really going to get like this full upper arm upper back and core workout When you're working it on this horizontal you're getting all this deltoid coming up Olivia joins the circus No she really does We'll be right back Welcome back to L A unscripted You're about to see Olivia de Bortoli do something I have always wanted to do Be a part of Cirque de Soleil The new show is right here in Socal and Olivia got to be a life size bug It started over 30 years ago with only 20 performers Now Cirque Du Soleil is one of

the greatest shows on Earth And it's coming back to L A Ready Cir Soleil was created in 1984 in Canada by basically a group of street performers They set out to basically re invent circuits really offer something new without animals with really the imagination the artistry the human boundaries pushing them into the limits And through the year as they grew into this international global company OVO is just one of those shows that exist and that's now touring and that will now be at the Microsoft Theater here in Los Angeles Each show by Cirque Du Soleil has like a different theme Ovo is inspired by sex So our 52 artists are all different bugs We've got night butterflies and spiders and a dragonfly and a firefly and crickets that have this intricate costume We follow the story of this outsider this Voyager our fly who basically lands in and comes into the new colony and kind of disrupts the colony We'll see the story of how they adapt and adapting to change is a very present theme in our world at the moment Very much an accessible show for kids So it's good for everybody here Tell me a little bit about the training that goes into this Yeah a lot of us come from a circus dance gymnastics background We've all been training since we were quite young We've been creating the show in Montreal the last few months and now we're finally premiering it here in Los Angeles It'll be our first time here in the theater So we're all really So let's do some acrobatic So show me what's a trick that I you know we a beginner hand put your hands down OK I'll hold your legs kick up Great and come down Perfect OK cool That's easy These two what's something level up from that level up Perfect Give a demonstration All right You ready So the the fee that you want first Yeah OK 123 Thank you guys That was so cool Los Angeles is so well known for the arts and for movies and for such talent in the show business that to be able to be here and to call the Microsoft theater our home for the next two months and to really perform here It's a unique so jealous That looks so cool But I did get to have my own high flying adventure Thanks to a little school I went to with my good friend Liberty Chan I'm Kevin here at Tsny Los Angeles Dana I dare you to come fly high with me here on the Santa Monica pier I am here to do your dare I think I brought her some support because she's really good at this stuff I'm not trippie school was started by a pair of doctors in 2002 and started on the Santa Monica pier in 2008 We have four current schools across the US One here one in DC Chicago and New York This is an actual school We offer single serving classes here We also offer workshops from beginners to advanced flyers to occasionally we get professional flyers that get to train here as well Head for chest tie Sha Behind us You were a

little like like klutzy but you know like it's fine it's fine I'll show you but it was so much fun I felt like a trapeze artist Like I want to join the circus now Like it was so fun Are you scared You know I'm scared of heights You know it's like one of those things that it doesn't look that high but when you get up there it looks really high up You gotta go Yeah How do I get myself into this This is a code violation thing OK You ready OK Oh my God I like this No no no no All I listen Yeah Yeah You faced your fear I did it and you did it twice I'm really glad it's over Yeah I'm really glad I did it No we can train we can like join the circus I'm gonna hard pass God I do not like heights I really need to rethink some of the things I'm willing to take on a dare Ok Thank you guys so much for hanging out with us We'll see you next time Good night
